

## Public Hearings Called by City Council; Other Action Taken

The Medford city council Thursday night, among its items of miscellaneous business, gave the engineering department the authority to draw on the general fund for engineering costs.

The department can now draw on the general fund to pay for immediate engineering costs incurred on special assessment projects, and then reimburse the fund when the assessments are paid. The actual monies will come from surplus funds in the Improvement Bond fund.

Following public hearings, the council ordered the installation of a water main on Oakwood dr. from Glen Oak court to Barneburg rd. and on Barneburg rd. from Oakwood dr. to Woodlawn dr.; and it also ordered Stevens st. to be paved from Crater Lake ave., 1,446 feet west.

A request to annex to the city some property in the Chestnut st. area was deferred until the council's second meeting in January, because the property owners have not yet carried out several con-

ditions recommended by the planning commission.

Public hearings were called by the council for Jan. 5 on the following items:

- A requested change of zone from Class IA to Class II at the northwest corner of Crater Lake ave. and Stevens st.
- A request to annex to the city some property east of Foothills rd. south of Fairview dr. and adjacent to the Rogue Valley Country club holdings.

- A request to annex to the city some Central Avenue church property on Holmes ave. and Oakdale ave.

- A request to annex to the city some property east of Foothills rd. south of Fairview dr. and adjacent to the Rogue Valley Country club holdings.

Public hearings were called for Jan. 16 on the following items:

- A proposal to vacate 14th st. from Hamilton to Peach sts.
- A proposal to vacate a portion of Crews rd.

The council granted re-issuance of a car wrecker license to Huffman Auto Parts, 1618 North Riverside ave.

It approved a variance for a carport at 542 Mae st. and called for bids on a water main construction project on Oakwood dr. and Barneburg rd.

Several projects were accepted by the council. They

were paving Lawrence ave. from Black Oak dr., 465 feet east; paving Ruth dr. from Lawrence ave., 425 feet south-east; a sanitary sewer on Lawrence ave. from Black Oak dr., 465 feet east; and a sanitary sewer on Ruth dr. from Lawrence ave., 425 feet southeast.

**Approve License**

The council approved issuance of a liquor license to Shakey's Pizza parlor, which

proposed to build at Jackson st. and Central ave. An extension of time was granted for construction of 10th st. from Riverside ave. to Wilamette ave.

At the request of City Manager Robert A. Duff, the council directed the fire marshal to determine if a barn and fence located on East Jackson st. adjacent to Oregon terrace is a fire or traffic hazard. The barn and fence are

owned by O. H. Bengston, according to a petition bearing 31 signatures which was turned into the city manager requesting the city to remove the structures.






