



Kefauver Asks Tighter Control On Drug Industry

Washington—(UPI)—Chairman Estes Kefauver of the Senate drug investigating subcommittee has called for more federal regulations to protect the American public from phony medicines.

Kefauver, (D-Tenn.), said Sunday night the Food and Drug Administration should be required to go beyond its present practice of simply declaring a drug non-poisonous. He said the FDA should be required to show that a new medicine was worthwhile.

Such a regulation would "stop a lot of this quackery," he said.

Kefauver also said his anti-trust and monopoly subcommittee's hearings into the drug industry earlier this year have already done an "enormous amount of good."

The publicity of the hearings, he said, had caused a 15 per cent reduction in the prices of a broad range of antibiotics which could save the American people "somewhere around \$70 or \$80 million a year in penicillin and many, many other drugs."

Air Crash Victim's Funeral Tuesday

Chicago—(UPI)—Funeral services will be held Tuesday for little Stephen Baltz, 11, for a time the sole survivor of Friday's New York air disaster.

The boy died Saturday, 26 hours after the jetliner he was riding collided with a Constellation over New York City.

Stephen's coffin arrived here Sunday night from Idlewild airport, the destination he never reached Friday.

His grieving parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Baltz, refused an offer of two free seats on a commercial airliner for the trip back to their home in suburban Wilmette, Ill. Instead they took a train.

Five Oregonians Die in Accidents

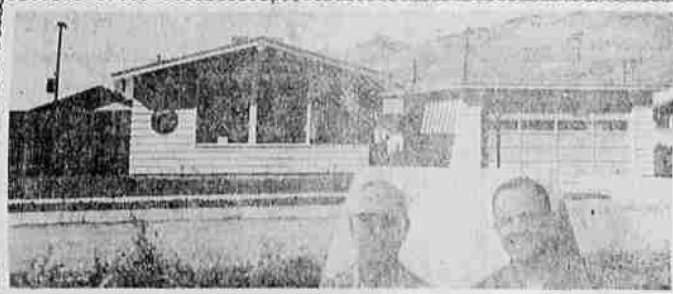
