The Medical Roundup

Nausea

Many people want to know why they have nausea, and I cannot say because there are so many causes. One is pure nerves. Sometimes a tense, self-conscious girl will get nausea when she tries to go to dinner with a lad. As a result, she cannot eat anything. A very busy, hard-working dentist who, when he is tired and in need of a vacation, wakes every night about 2 a.m., and sits up for an hour, nauseated. The day he leaves on his vacation he is cured.

Another "functional" cause is food sensitiveness. When I was a child, I used to get terribly nauseated after eating chicken gravy, which I loved. I also loved ham fat, but after a slice of boiled ham, I would develop such nausea I could not take another bite.

Nausea is, of course, a terrible trial to some women during pregnancy. Fortunately, of late, several drugs have been synthesized which tend to stop nausea. These drugs are very helpful in relieving the nausea produced by motion, or in a car on a curvy mountain road. A tendency to such motion-sickness runs through certain families. Nausea is common in cases of intestinal obstruction, or acute appendicitis. I remember a man of 60, previously always well, whose first symptom of cancer of his large bowel was nausea.

The taking of some drugs will produce nausea. Rarely, I will see a very sensitive young woman who gets nauseated when she is menstruating, or when she is constipated. I remember a woman who told me she became badly nauseated when she found an inchworm in her salad! Other women I have known could get nauseated with almost any cause of disgust. Many migrainous women get spells of nausea with a sick headache, or in their case, a spell of nausea may take the place of a headache. Meniere's disease of the ears can make nausea. I think anything that causes waves or ripples to run back up the bowel and into the stomach is likely to cause nausea.
