

Cold Areas Get Slight Relief

Light snow and gentle southerly winds brought slight relief today to bitter cold areas of the East and Midwest.

Beginning in the Dakotas and Northern Maine, snow swept south through Indiana and the Ohio Valley, changing to occasional showers throughout the south.

At Corpus Christi, Tex., torrential rains began during the night and poured down 3.52 inches in six hours.

In New York state, scene of temperatures down to 31 degrees below zero Wednesday, the mercury hovered around zero to 10 above. Remaining cold spots across the nation were at West Yellowstone, Mont., with 24 below; Fraser, Colo., 18 below; and Lebanon, N.H., 11 below.

Weather in the Far West was generally fair today except for Pacific Northwest showers in Washington and light snow in Eastern Washington, Idaho and Montana.

Four 1960 Babies May Be Rulers

Four boys who were born in 1960 could someday rule the four countries of their births. A fifth baby is the son of the President-elect of the United States.

The infants whose births made headlines were:

Prince Andrew Albert Christian Edward, born Feb. 19 to Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip of Britain, second in line of succession to the throne, after his brother Prince Charles.

Prince Naruhito Hironomiya of Japan, born Feb. 23 to Crown Prince Akihito and Princess Michiko, second in line of succession, following his father.

Prince Philippe Leopold Louis Marie of Belgium, born April 15 to Prince Albert and Princess Paola, second in line of succession to King Baudouin, following his father who is the king's brother.

Crown Prince Reza Pahlavi, born Oct. 31 to the Shah of Iran and his third wife, Princess Farah Diba, heir to the Peacock Throne of Iran.

John Fitzgerald Kennedy Jr., born Nov. 25 to President-elect John F. Kennedy and his wife, Jacqueline.

Russian Space Attempt Expected

London—UPI—Western scientists said today the Soviets may rocket a man into orbit or land a robot laboratory on the moon to coincide with the inauguration of President John F. Kennedy on Jan. 20.

Both projects were in their final stages some months ago, according to information from behind the Iron Curtain, and there are mounting indications that a big new space project is imminent.

The moon laboratory is known to have been completed since then, but the man-in-space venture suffered a setback when Space Ship II burned up on reentry earlier this month.

News reports said Western Intelligence indicates unusual activity is currently taking place at Soviet satellite launching bases and that Russian missile monitoring ships are preparing to move out to their stations in the Pacific and Indian oceans.

Balloon-Carried Telescope Tested

Washington—UPI—Scientists have begun testing a balloon-carried telescope they hope will unlock some of the secrets of the universe. It is theoretically powerful enough to distinguish two golf balls 15 inches apart at a distance of 500 miles.

Scientists hope the project, called Stratoscope II, will bring back from the fringe of space the first photos of the cloud-shrouded surface of Venus, data to solve the mystery of Jupiter's mammoth red spot and clues to the birth of stars.

The National Science Foundation, the Navy and Princeton University disclosed in a joint statement Wednesday night that testing of the balloon and telescope had started. The scientists hope to send Stratoscope II up to take pictures next fall.

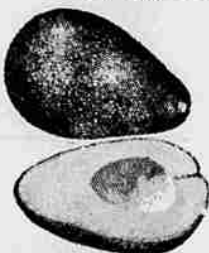
