Transfusions of Blood

Dangerous

People keep asking me to say again why I fear transfusions. I greatly fear them because so many donors, in spite of every precaution that can be taken, carry in their blood the virus of serum hepatitis. If I should have a transfusion and the donor should have the virus in him, I probably would be down on my back in two or three months, suffering from an inflammation of my liver that could make me very ill. It could leave me handicapped for life with a cirrhosis of the liver, and it could even kill me.

Is it any wonder, then, that every so often I read in some medical journal an editorial by some great expert on blood-begging us doctors to quit ordering transfusions for people who almost certainly would recover from their illness or operation without the help of blood? Is it any wonder that recently the chief legal counsel for the American Medical Association begged us doctors not to give transfusions of doubtful necessity? As he said, what with serum hepatitis, transfusion reactions (sometimes alarming) and mix-ups in blood groupings, or in giving the right blood to the wrong person with the same family name, "Blood for transfusion is dynamic."

Go To Extremes

No one will ever give me a transfusion unless I very

much need one to save my life, as after a severe hemorrhage from a stomach ulcer or an accident.

I can imagine many people asking, "But if blood can so wreck a person's health or kill him, why do doctors give it when they don't have to?" And I think the answer is that some of us, in our great desire to do everything to get a sick person well, go to extremes. Our zeal carries us away. Also there are hundreds of thousands of men and women who love the doctor who over-treats them. They think he is wonderful. Other people don't want to be over-treated.

I am reminded of an evening long ago when one of my children aged 6 was down with a very mild case of chickenpox—usually a disease which needs no treatment. But my wife got anxious and sent for a children's specialist who sent his assistant—a young woman who apparently thought I would be pleased if she showed "real zeal." So, when I got home, I found she had ordered for the child a dose of castor oil; a bottle of medicine to lower the slight fever, some calamine lotion to protect the skin, and some iodine boric acid solution to be dropped in the child's eyes every hour throughout the night.

Whole Family Slept

Partly because I saw no sense in any of this treatment, and partly because that day my wife was so tired and ill that she was in no shape to be up all night applying the medicine, I put my foot down and said, "None of that." I took a sleeping tablet; broke it in three parts and gave one to the child and the other two thirds to my wife. As a result, the whole family slept well all night, and in the morning the child woke up well.

Cuba's Attitude Shows Nervousness

Havana—UPI—Official treatment of American newsmen covering Monday's anniversary celebration here reflected the nervousness and confusion of the Castro regime's attitude toward the U.S. press.

When Henry Raymont of UPI, the only U.S. correspondent on the reviewing stand, asked to use a telephone, a major in Castro's militia ushered him to the government tourist office in the Marti Monument.

Moments later, he was cut off by an official of the Dier (secret police), who notified him curtly that "journalists are not allowed to use government telephones."

An official of the Foreign Ministry immediately intervened, telling the Dier men "you must be courteous to all."
