down, the boy's temperament changes markedly, and he becomes very happy.

The operation is generally performed in stages. First, if the cords are long enough, the testicles are brought down, and each is fastened to the inner side of the thigh. Later, when the cords have adjusted to the new length, the testicles are separated from the thighs and inserted in the scrotum (sac).

One reason for bringing the testicles down early is that if they are left too long in the abdomen, their ability to make fertile spermatozoa may be greatly lessened.

Human Skeleton Found Near Bend

Bend, Ore.—A human skeleton, believed to represent a prehistoric burial, has been found in a cave in the gorge of Crooked river northeast of here.

The skeleton, buried in dust and dirt at the rear of the cave in the base of a volcanic formation, was discovered by a Crooked river rancher.

The area, in the sheltered river bottom, has long been recognized as a promising site for early-day Indians.

ECTOPIC PREGNANCY

Every so often a woman who has missed a few periods and who thinks she is normally pregnant will get pain in her pelvis with perhaps some bleeding from the womb. In a few cases there is urination and fainting.

Dr. H. M. Nelson and Dr. S. Guindl, of Detroit, recently pointed out that such women ought to go immediately to their physicians because of the possibility that the little fetus is developing in one of their tubes on the side of the womb. Eventually, the tube is likely to rupture, and then the woman bleeds internally — so much so, perhaps, that unless she is quickly operated on she will lose her life.

In none of the 171 cases reported by Drs. Nelson and Guindl had the tube yet ruptured when the woman was operated on. In one-quarter of the cases, when the doctor examined the woman he

could feel a mass in her pelvis. In some cases, laboratory examination showed a decided loss of blood. A pregnancy test, when used, was positive in 35 cases, and negative in 15 cases. Obviously, this test is not always helpful. Often the diagnosis is very difficult to make even by an expert.

The condition may suggest a pelvic inflammation, an acute appendicitis, a twisted ovarian cyst, trouble in a fibroid tumor, a ruptured diverticulum of the colon, or something wrong with a kidney.

Whenever the physicians were in doubt they examined the woman under anesthesia. Then with the abdominal wall relaxed, a physician can feel much more detail. Sometimes the doctors passed a hollow needle into the pelvic cavity behind the womb. When the fluid obtained was bloody, an operation was immediately performed.

Many parents write to say that their boy's testicles have not come down. Their doctor has tried "shots" of male hormone (testicular extract) but these have had no effect. Now the question is, when should the operation be performed and what is it like? I always insist that the operation be performed early, let us say about the age of 10. What is very bad is to leave the defect uncorrected after the lad's swimming-mates have discovered it, and have started jeering at him.

This jeering at the boy's lack of a decided sign of masculinity is very likely soon to make him bitter, moody, and retiring. He is likely to lock himself in his room, to go on long walks alone. He won't go out with either boys or girls. If asked if he wants to be operated on he will say that it means nothing to him, but this is not true. The day the testicles are brought
