Tip May Be Clue To Missing Plane

Silverton — (UPI) — Three plywood mill workers said Wednesday they viewed a plane dip and then saw a streak of smoke east of here Jan. 30.

The Oregon Aeronautics Board said the plane might possibly have been the one missing on a Portland to Pasco, Wash., flight since that day.

The board said the report would be checked out as soon as weather permitted.

The plane carried Mr. and Mrs. Ralph Brown of San Leandro, Calif.

Aeronautics Director Earl Snyder said he had not idea why the plane, scheduled to fly northeast from Portland to Pasco, would have been headed in a southeasterly direction.

U. S. Recognizes El Salvador Junta

Washington — (UPI) — The United States has recognized the military junta which took over the government of El Salvador on Jan. 25.

President Kennedy told his news conference Wednesday night that recognition was granted following assurances from the new government to "bring about free and democratic elections" and to seek solutions to the country's economic and social difficulties.

The new junta, composed of two military and three civilian members, overthrew another junta which also had been recognized by the United States soon after it came to power last Oct. 26.

Stroke Takes Life of Veteran Congressman

Washington — (UPI) — Rep. W. F. Norrell (D-Ark.), a 22-year House veteran, died of a stroke Wednesday night in Walter Reed Army Hospital.

The 64-year-old legislator was stricken at his Capitol office three days ago and had been hospitalized since then.

PICKETS FOLLOW JFK

Washington — (UPI) — Aircraft flight engineers picketed President Kennedy's news conference Wednesday night in protest to a National Mediation Board order that would put them under the Air Line Pilots association.

The engineers, who say membership in the pilot's union will eventually mean loss of their jobs, planned to picket the White House today.
