Should a Doctor Tell a Patient He Has Cancer?

For years, physicians have thought it their duty not to tell patients that they have a serious or fatal illness. Half a century ago, when I started practice, I tried lying, as I had been taught to do, but often the results were so bad that I decided thereafter to tell the truth whenever the patient asked for it. I say nothing when an apathetic old person lets his children handle everything and asks me no questions.

I think that whenever a patient looks me in the eye and asks, "What did you find, doctor?" it is my moral and also my legal duty to tell him the truth. I was interested in 1957 to read in a magazine that an attorney, John S. Montedonico, had expressed his opinion that a doctor is legally bound to tell the truth. Often, a business man should quickly know the truth if only so that he can put his financial house in order. I have known cases in which, because the doctor failed to tell even the man's wife the truth, the patient left his affairs in such a snarl that it took years to prepare his estate for probate.

Hundreds of times I have had a patient's relatives say to me, "Don't tell him if you find cancer; he couldn't take it; he'd commit suicide." Hundreds of times I have told the man or woman the truth, and so far I have not heard of one suicide due to my action. People are much braver than their relatives give them credit for.

Often Naive
Relatives of a man or woman with a cancer often are remarkably naive. They will

who has a cancerous breast removed and was told that nothing seriously wrong was found, suffers a return of the disease. Perhaps in a year or two she gets severe pains in her chest, with shortness of breath. When this woman is taken to a consultant, what is that poor man to do? He will know in a moment from her story what is wrong, but he will have to go ahead and examine her and x-ray her. Perhaps the husband, suspicious by now, will demand to be shown the films, and they will show the ribs full of daughter growths, and perhaps the lung cavities half full of cancerous fluid.

The consultant must then treat the woman if he is to give her all the relief he can, but he cannot very well order x-ray treatment without telling the truth. Then the husband may be very angry with the home doctor, and the home doctor will be angry with the consultant. Time and again I have had a hard time calming such people down—trying to get them to see that the home doctor had done only what he had been trained to think was the kindest thing to do.

It's later than you think and today—not tomorrow—is the time to have a physical check-up to guard against cancer.
