Wryneck in Children

Recently, Drs. Mark B. Coventry, Lloyd E. Harris, Anthony J. Blanco Jr., and Arthur H. Bullock of the Mayo Clinic had a fine paper on infants and children who always have had their head pulled over to one side by a contraction in the muscles or tendons on one side of the neck. Often the cause for this is not known, but I think it highly significant that in 40 per cent of the Mayo Clinic cases the child had been born breech first. This means that the obstetrician had to pull pretty hard to get the head born quickly, before the infant lost his life by strangulation. In such a case the child will be fortunate today if the obstetrician had a sixth sense which told him just how hard he dared pull without tearing a neck muscle.

The Mayo doctors tell how, in these cases, the contracted tissue in the neck can be cut; then the head can be straightened and held in a cast until recovery has taken place. The operation can be performed at any time after one year of age. Usually there is complete correction of the wryneck, but if the operation is delayed until after the 12th or 14th year, correction may be impossible.

Cerebral Palsy

Many people with a crippled child ask me where they can get a book on cerebral palsy. I have just been reading an excellent one by Drs. Denhoff and Robinson (McGraw-Hill). It gives an enormous amount of information about these children and what can be done for them. Unfortunately, the text is a bit too technical for any but well-educated parents.

Piles Do Not Become Cancerous

Many people ask me, "Will my piles become cancerous," and I say, "No." But I must go on to say that a high percentage of persons with cancer of the rectum will lose their lives because they and their doctors will keep assuming for too long a time that their bleeding is coming from some piles. We must all remember that many a person with piles has in addition a cancer a couple of inches farther up.
