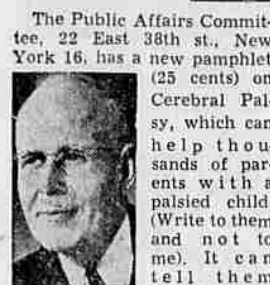

The Public Affairs Committee, 22 East 38th st., New York 16, has a new pamphlet (25 cents) on Cerebral Palsy, which can help thousands of parents with a child who is physically handicapped. (Write to them and not to me). It can tell them much about the disease, and it can tell them what to read, and where to write for help and information. It tells where they can get scholarship aid, postgraduate training, and so forth. There are a number of organizations that help with these children.

Cerebral palsy results from damage to the brain before, during, or after birth. Naturally, then, there are a number of causes, some of them still obscure. Recently, less importance has been attached to mechanical injuries during birth and more to an injury to

the child's brain early in pregnancy. Rarely, there may have been an injury wrought by the Rh factor. There appears, also, to be a factor of heredity in some families. Parents should never have a sense of guilt about having begotten a cerebral palsied child.

Different children have different degrees of handicap. Some are so badly off that they cannot talk or walk or feed themselves, or go to the bathroom alone. There are speech defects in from 50 to 75 per cent of the children; mental retardation in perhaps 50 per cent; troubles with sight in about 50 per cent; occasional convulsions in perhaps 35 per cent; and impairment of hearing in 25 per cent.

The wonderful thing is that with expert training many children who originally were unable to do anything for themselves later can take care of themselves. Some do well at school, and some are able to do some work with which they can support themselves. Suggestions as to all this are to be found in the booklet.

Burglars Get \$643 In Happy Camp

Happy Camp - Burglars broke into a Happy Camp store Thursday night and took \$643 the owner had hidden under a vegetable rack for safe keeping.

The Week in California

Unemployment Is Top News in California; Increase Is Noted

United Press International - California unemployment during January reached its "highest point in a decade" when the number of jobless persons in the state totaled 517,000.

Employment Director Irving Perless said the January unemployment totaled 8 per cent of the labor force - 65,000 more jobless than during last December, when unemployment rose to 6.9 per cent.

The new figures also indicated 148,000 more unemployed than January a year ago, when unemployment reached 5.9 per cent of the work force.

Almost simultaneously, Gov. Edmund G. Brown released a recession report on 13 "representative counties" of the state and sent a wire to President Kennedy reporting on California's moves to alleviate the recession.

Share of Aid - Brown said the state's \$58 million share of federal highway aid was being put out to bid at the rate of \$35-\$40 million monthly compared to the normal rate of \$58 million.

The report on the 13 counties submitted to the Brown by State Social Welfare Director John M. Wedemeyer said unemployment in some of them "is the worst since the depression of the 1930's."

Wedemeyer told Brown the report was compiled from the findings of crews of investigators in Los Angeles, San Diego, Alameda, Santa Clara, Contra Costa, Riverside, Kern, Stanislaus, Fresno, Marin, Humboldt, Mendocino and Shasta counties.

Wedemeyer's report on the 13 counties included these comments: **Jobless in January** - Estimated 21 per cent of the labor force covered by unemployment insurance was jobless in January.

"A utility company reported a 400 per cent increase in shutoff notices in the past year and a doubled discontinuation of service rate... instances of hungry people stealing cattle... one (man) reported 'spotlighting' deer at the rate of about one a week... reports of other missing stock... unemployment worse than any time since the recession."

Riverside - Combined with San Bernardino, January unemployment was estimated at 8 per cent. "Red Cross reported a great many people going back into Army service in the Indian area, estimating 55 per cent were ex-Army men who can't get jobs."

Elsewhere, there were these developments:

Writer: Dalton Trumbo, one of Hollywood's so-called "unfriendly ten" of the 1940's, was nominated for a Screen Writers award for the 1960 film "Spartacus." The film was one of the few for which Trumbo received title credit since his appearances before

Congressional committees after World War II.

Kuchel: Sen. Thomas Kuchel, R-California, declared that a move by President Kennedy to channel defense contracts to labor surplus areas is "regrettable, unfortunate and illegal." Kuchel told a press conference in Los Angeles that no defense department funds shall be appropriated "for the purpose of relieving economic dislocations." He asserted that the government must allocate contracts on the basis of "the best job that can be done for our defense at the lowest possible price."

Congo: Dr. Ralph Bunche, United Nations Undersecretary for Political Affairs, said the Congo murder of Patrice Lumumba would make him a martyr. His death, Bunche said in an address to Stanford university students, would have "widespread and profound repercussions." But Bunche added that "in spite of this and other discouraging factors on the international level, I continue to be optimistic that we can avert World War III."

Bunch: Admitted triple strangler Henry Adolph Bunch was formally sentenced in Los Angeles to die in the California gas chamber for first-degree murder of his aunt, Bunch, 29, an optical worker, showed no emotion as Superior Judge Edwin L. Jefferson carried out the directive of a jury which convicted him of three murders and fixed death as the penalty for strangling Mrs. Margaret Briggs, 53, his aunt.

Divorce: Movie star Ann Miller filed a Valentine's Day divorce suit against her wealthy Texas oilman husband, William Moss Jr. The 37-year-old dancer-singer charged extreme cruelty and asked for a restraining order allowing her full use of the family home.

Crash: An Air National Guard pilot who ejected from his disabled jet trainer over the Sierra foothills near Fresno was found alive. He was Col. Roy Santin, 42, of Sacramento, who suffered slight injuries in bailing from his plane at about 20,000 feet.

Society To Show Film in Medford

A series of free films will be shown by the American Cancer Society throughout Jackson county March 1.

The show on uterine cancer, "Time and Two Women," will be shown at the Holly theater, Medford, and the Varsity theater, Ashland, at 10 a.m.; at Bellview Grange hall, Ashland, at 2 p.m., and the Rogue River Grange hall, Rogue River, at 7:30 p.m.

The society estimates there will be about 300 new Oregon women affected by uterine cancer this year. Theme of the film is that time can be either a woman's ally or her enemy in the detection of uterine cancer, specifically cervical cancer.

Detection in its early and most easily curable stages is now possible through a uterine cell examination called the "Pap smear." The test is named for Dr. George N. Papanicolaou, Cornell Medical college scientist, who developed and perfected it while studying American Cancer Society research grants totaling more than \$500,000.

The statewide series of free movies will begin Feb. 25 in Klamath Falls, and will end March 23 in Portland and Multnomah county.

School Librarians Hear Discussion of Unit's Importance

Two school superintendents and a department of education school library consultant were guest speakers at last week's meeting of the Jackson County Association of school librarians, held in the Central Point Junior High school library.

The speakers were Medford School Superintendent Leonard B. Mayfield, Central Point School Superintendent Charles Meyer and Library Consultant Miss Phyllis Hochstetler.

Secondary and elementary school librarians representing Ashland, Phoenix, Talent, Gold Hill, Rogue River, Central Point, Eagle Point and Medford attended.

Miss Hochstetler announced that increased training would be required for school librarians. She praised the local organization as a model to be held up all over the state.

Meyer defined the importance of the library in the total education program of the schools and predicted that school libraries would contribute more and more to daily classroom work as the "center of all school activity." Dr. Mayfield stated that he would "put our libraries up against any in the state," attributing this to the fact that the librarians push forward to instigate improvements. He urged increased teamwork among teachers and librarians, and said the success of the library program hinges on the personality of the librarian.

Elect Officers - Also at the meeting, the association elected officers for the 1961-62 school year. They are Ruth Kaye, president; Ruth-Esther Hill, vice president and program chairman; and Olive Fountain, secretary-treasurer.

Several of the activities for school librarians during the remainder of the school year include attendance at the joint library department of OEA and the Oregon Audio Visual association meeting in Portland March 16 to 18, and participation in the Oregon Library association conference.

Burglars Take Cigars From Ashland Cafe

The Wayside cafe on the South Pacific highway near Ashland was burglarized Friday night, state police said Saturday.

Thieves broke a window in the rear door, entered, and took 49 cigars and four boxes of candy bars, officers said.
