

Brine Shrimp Could Be Food Shortage Answer

Miami — (UPI) — Ed Nichols, a specialist in the feeding of captive fish, is hard at work on a project that could solve the problem of feeding man in space.

It might even offer part of the answer to one of the greatest questions facing humanity — how to take care of the food needs of the world's ever-expanding population.

Nichols' project involves brine shrimp, a close relative of the true shrimp. These tiny organisms thrive in such places as the Great Salt Lake in Utah and the salt-encrusted beds of California and the West Indies.

At present Nichols is "growing" billions of brine shrimp to feed the fish at Miami's Seaquarium. He has found that brine shrimp eggs can be dried and stored for 10 years. They will hatch after being placed in water for about 24 hours.

Nichols' experience has shown that 88 per cent of vacuum packed eggs will hatch and mature in about three weeks. But he also has found that these shrimp rarely grow to maturity in captivity. Once he can get across

this barrier Nichols believes he can make a great breakthrough in the field of nutrition.

Eggs Float

Brine shrimp lay their eggs in salty water. The eggs float, or are blown by the wind, to shores where they pile up in heavy windrows. Nichols collects brine shrimp eggs in shovels, dries them out and then places them in water again to permit them to hatch.

He thinks that vacuum packed brine shrimp would be ideal as a food supplement for men in far away places such as scientific and military installations in the Antarctic and on atomic submarines which stay submerged for many months.

While brine shrimp are not as tasty as the true species that show up in your shrimp cocktail, they have a distinct flavor, Nichols said.

Recently he made some soup with brine shrimp. "Not bad, but not too tasty, either, although undoubtedly nutritious," Nichols said. "They'd probably taste better with a little seasoning."

He advises against using salt.

Prolonged Space Flight May Not Come Before A Decade, Expert Says

Newport Beach, Calif. — (UPI) — Sometime during 1961 headlines may proclaim the first manned flight into space by the United States or Russia — but scientists believe it could take most of the next decade before man can be kept there more than a few hours at a time.

Writing in the January issue of *Aircraft and Missiles* magazine, Dr. Seymour Lampert of the aeronautics division of Ford Motor Co. says man finds himself on the threshold of the Space Age "with great ignorance of what to expect." And he points out that the most basic problems are yet to be solved before a man could stay in space for, say, a week.

U.S. plans call for an all-out X15 rocketship attempt to take a man at least 50 miles into space in February, and the first manned project Mercury capsule flights are scheduled later in the year. Since a completely sealed, pressurized cabin is needed to keep a man alive above 15 miles, these manned flights into space, but, Lampert, manager of Aeronautics' Aeromechanics department, points out these flights will last for only short periods.

What are the problems that must be solved before a man can stay in space a week?

Metals Evaporate

For one thing, Lampert says, there is the matter of what materials to use for a space ship's hull. In the vacuum of space, metals will tend to evaporate, and radiation will weaken the binding forces that hold molecules together.

Lampert acknowledges that the first satellites and probes have resulted "in significant discoveries related to the make-up and content of those regions beyond . . . our atmosphere."

But he adds that much of this data is still rather meager and in man's respects inconclusive.

One broad area in which data is sorely lacking is how to control the temperature inside a space ship. That will depend to a great extent on how much heat the outside skin of a vehicle reflects.

As an example, the skin temperature of a polished aluminum surface could vary from several hundred degrees Fahrenheit in one region of space to several hundred degrees below zero in another region of space. Manned space vehicles will be equipped with air conditioning, but what kind of air conditioning equipment will have to be designed to cope with the problems that would arise if the heat reflective ability of a ship's skin changes during a flight?
