The Medical Roundup

People ask what medicine to take for ileitis and I'm sorry to say I don't know of any good one.

It is probable that ileitis is due to some unknown virus, and this is why no antibiotic can be counted on to cure the disease. In cases of ileitis the lowest section of the small bowel is inflamed and thickened, and with this, there is likely to be some abdominal pain and perhaps some diarrhea. A woman just wrote to say she has had ileitis for 10 years without having it operated on. When ileitis is causing much trouble the best treatment usually is to have a surgeon remove the diseased segment of bowel. This works a cure in perhaps half of the cases.

Sometimes the disease returns in another part of the bowel. Some people who write tell me they dread the operation because they don't want to have an opening of the gut out onto the abdominal wall. Actually, if they are operated on, they won't have any external opening. The diseased section of the bowel will be removed and the two cut ends will then be brought together.

Many people ask about a diet for ileitis, but I do not know of any that will cure. Fortunately, it is a rare disease, but that fact makes it hard for us physicians to learn much about it.

Child With One Leg Shorter Than Other

Many a mother who has a child with one leg considerably shorter than the other may be interested in the work of my old friend, Dr. Joseph M. James, who with his associates at the Mayo Clinic, for some years has been producing what is called an arteriovenous fistula in the short leg. The change in the blood supply produced by connecting the artery with the vein—in quite a few cases—will cause the short leg to grow so that the person will not have to limp around for the rest of his or her days. The operation had better be performed between the ages of 8 and 10 years. Some four to six years later the opening between the artery and the vein is closed.
