Kennedy's Jobless Benefit Program Due in Senate

Washington—UPI—The Senate was scheduled today to open debate on a sharply altered version of President Kennedy's plan to extend \$1 billion in emergency unemployment benefits to jobless workers.

The Senate Finance Committee revised the House-passed bill Wednesday, virtually ending administration hopes to get the measure passed by Congress and in operation by April 1.

Provided the Senate passes its version, the bill would have to go back to the House for another vote.

Provision Retained

The Senate bill retained the House-approved provision to finance the program by boosting from 3.1 to 3.5 per cent the payroll taxes paid by employers. And the Senate committee went along with the extra 13 weeks of compensation for workers who have exhausted regular state benefits, but limited total payments to 39 weeks.

Chief changes were an amendment providing that the states would get back in aid only what they contributed in higher payroll taxes—and the committee's stipulation that the tax boost be made effective this year, instead of in 1962.

Override Expected

Prospects were that the Senate would override administration objections to the changes in the House measure and approve the amended bill.

Other congressional news: **Highways:** Rep. John Taber of New York, dean of House Republicans, said Kennedy's highway programs would "tax America's truckers out of business." Taber told the House Ways and Means Committee that if there was a danger the road program would be delayed by lack of money, the federal gasoline tax should be continued at the present four cents a gallon.

Payrolls: House members voted to allow themselves an extra \$6,781 for their staff payrolls. The action would mean individual members could either add a new staff employee or spread some or all of the extra allowance among present employees. Only 23 congressmen stood to be counted against the proposal out of 367 who had answered a quorum call a few minutes before the vote.

Honest Man's Son Takes Studio Job

Hollywood—UPI—The son of Douglas Johnson, the unemployed janitor who returned \$240,000 cash to the armored car firm which had lost it, has been given a summer job in a movie studio.

Richard Johnson, 16, who says his ambition is to become an actor, will be able to work around Allied Artists studios during the summer and will be considered for possible movie roles, the studio announced Wednesday.

Richard, a sophomore at Los Angeles high school, studies dramatics in his spare time.

His father found the money last Friday in a bag that tumbled from a Brink's armored truck. The firm has offered him a steady \$90-a-week job as a guard and said it would like to give Richard a college scholarship.

Johnson said he would announce Monday whether he will accept Brink's' offers.
