The Medical Roundup

Shouldn't We Doctors More Often Talk to Our Patients? What distresses me about the practice of medicine today is that, judging from the hundreds of letters I get, a large number of physicians are not talking to our patients. When asked anxious questions we may walk away. A woman with a skin lesion just wrote that when she asked the specialist who had examined her, what the disease was, he said, "Here's a prescription," and walked out of the room. A man who suffers from dizzy spells says his doctor took his blood pressure but when asked how high it was, he grunted, and went to see the next patient.

Every year I get a score of letters from frantic mothers who say they have a son who has Hodgkin's disease, but no doctor would say what the disease is; what chance is there for curing it, and how long is the lad likely to live. Everyone just said curdy, "Go to the x-ray man."

Some weeks ago a lovely woman came into my office. I soon discovered she was torn with anxiety. She said that of late she has been blue and depressed, and uninterested in her husband, her children, and her home. In years past she always has been a strong, active and cheerful person. Some months ago when she had some dizzy spells and morning headaches she went to her doctor. He took her blood pressure, said, "It's high," gave her a prescription for a tranquilizer which often reduces blood pressure, and dismissed her. She had a dozen questions she much wanted to ask him, but his nurse came and took her away.

Has Good Reason Now, why is she so frightened and anxious over her depression? She has good reason to be. When I asked her about her family, she admitted that her aunt and her brother are in mental hospitals.

Oklahoma City—A shrine to the American cowboy is taking shape on a hill overlooking a cross-country highway here.

Construction is being done by phases on the National Cowboy Hall of Fame and Museum at the hillside site on an expressway which carries traffic from U.S. 86 and two other major highways.

The \$5 million project is a joint venture of 17 western states. It was conceived by the late C. A. Reynolds of Kansas City in 1947. Trustees from the states chose Oklahoma City as the site in 1955, and each state has carried on fund drives to finance the structure.
