AN ORDINANCE declaring the Council's intent to cause the construction of curbs on both sides of East Pine Street from Ninth Street to Eastern City Limits of the City of Central Point, Oregon, and to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to and benefited by such improvement, its proportionate share of the cost thereof as provided by the Charter of the City of Central Point.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL POINT DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That it is the intention of the Council to cause East Pine Street from Ninth Street to Eastern City Limits of the City of Central Point to be improved by the construction of curbs on both sides thereof in accordance with plans and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Recorder at the City Hall in Central Point, Oregon, to which plans and specifications reference is hereby made, and to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to and benefited by such improvement, its proportionate share of the cost thereof as provided by the Charter of the City of Central Point.

Section 2: The Council will meet at the City Hall in Central Point on April 4, 1961 at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., at which time and place the owners of said adjacent property are hereby called upon to appear before the Council and show cause, if any, why said street should not be improved, as aforesaid, in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the City Recorder, now on file in the office of the City Recorder at the City Hall in Central Point, Oregon, to which plans and specifications reference is hereby made, and to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to and benefited by such improvement, its proportionate share of the cost thereof as provided by the Charter of the City of Central Point.

Section 3: The City Recorder is hereby directed to serve notice of said hearing upon the aforesaid property owners by publishing this ordinance once in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Central Point, at least ten (10) days before the date of said hearing, and by posting five (5) copies of this ordinance, one thereof at each of five (5) public and conspicuous places in the City of Central Point, for a period of ten (10) days prior to said hearing.

AN ORDINANCE declaring the Council's intent to cause the construction of curbs on both sides of the paving of Eighth Street from the Southern end of Eighth Street to Hazel Street in the City of Central Point, Oregon, and to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to and benefited by such improvement, its proportionate share of the cost thereof as provided by the Charter of the City of Central Point.
