Do Men Have a Change of Life?

Many people ask me about a male menopause or "change of life." Some do not question that there is such a condition, while others wonder if what they have read somewhere about it is true. I imagine that many physicians would say that some men around the age of 50 go through a mental crisis.

Often, when this happens, I suspect it is due largely to the man's tendency to be dissatisfied with whatever type of success has come to him. Perhaps with the departure of his children from his home he feels the more dissatisfied with his unhappy marriage. Perhaps he gets to wondering if still he could get out of the business he has always disliked, and into one much more congenial to his tastes. Or, perhaps he gets to thinking that if ever he is to find happiness with a woman, he had better find it soon, before it is too late. Perhaps like H. M. Tomlinson, who years ago wrote, "The Sea and the Jungle," he much wants to escape from a commuter's treadmill, and to get away into a lazy life, perhaps in the South Seas.

Can Be No Doubt

I have never been able to accept the idea of a male change of life due to atrophy of the testes, corresponding to that of women, which is due to atrophy of the ovaries. In women there can be no doubt about the shrinking of the ovaries and the loss of most of their function. The resultant nervous changes which, if they are to come at all, usually come soon after the cessation of the menses, are well known and easily recognizable. I am sure there is no such typical group of symptoms in men. Also, a man's testicles do not shrink and lose their function around the age of 50. There are many cases on record in which a man in his 80s has fathered a child. Another objection to the idea of a male menopause is the fact that when a physician sees a case of what he thinks is this condition, and gives the man many injections of male hormone, the result is likely to be nil.

Another fact is that when a man of 50 suffers a slight depression and his doctor thinks he is in a male menopause the chances are that the patient has no lack of sexual interest and potency. An answer to the last argument is, of course, that many normal men remain sexually normal after the menopause. In the cases of both men and women sexual normalcy often depends more on the mental attitude than on the functions of the glands of the body.
