

Cost Estimates Made On Tentative Road Program in County

The tentative 1961-62 Jackson county road program includes 26.65 miles of grading and graveling at an estimated total cost of \$466,945 and 29.34 miles of oiling and paving at a total estimated cost of \$260,480, according to County Engineer Robert J. Carstensen.

The county engineer explained that this program is tentative so far since the county court has not approved the proposals yet. This proposed program compares with \$478,720 for 41.59 miles of grading

and graveling in the 1960-61 road schedule and \$254,405 for 38.13 miles of oiling and paving in the 1960-61 schedule. However, not all of these projects have been completed. Some of the grading and graveling must be completed this spring and some of the oiling and paving must be finished this summer.

Spring Completion

Those grading and graveling projects to be completed this spring are one mile on Corey rd. at an estimated cost of \$9,000; 1.10 miles on the

Foothill rd., from Vilas rd. to Coker Butte rd., at \$12,920; Poorman creek, 1.50 miles, at \$31,500; Elk creek, one mile, at \$21,000; Applegate rd., 2.69 miles, at \$40,000. If these projects are not completed before the new fiscal year starts July 1, then they will be rebudgeted and carried over into the new program.

Those oiling and paving projects in the current program to be rebudgeted and done this summer are: Hamrick rd., paving of .35 mile, \$3,000; Rogue River drive,

mat coat on 1.50 miles, \$8,375; Ala Vista, mat coat on one mile, \$4,250; Corey rd., mat coat on one mile, \$4,250; and Foothill rd., Vilas rd. to Coker Butte rd., mat coat on 1.10 miles, \$4,680.

Tentative grading and graveling for the 1961-62 program include: Corey rd. (Foothill rd. to Kershaw rd.) .5 mile, \$7,000; Kershaw rd., Corey rd. to Antelope rd., .75 mile, \$7,875; South Fork of the Little Butte rd., Lake Creek rd., east, 2.5 miles, \$65,000; Butte Falls rd., from Bowen Creek rd. to Willow Creek rd., three miles, \$63,000; Laurel st. (in town of Butte Falls), .12 mile, \$2,520; Rogue River drive, from Dry creek north, 1.3 miles, \$27,300; Evans Creek rd., from Bybee grade and Antioch section, 1.8 miles, \$47,700; Sykes Creek rd. (Extension to north), .75 mile, \$13,500.

Other tentative grading and graveling projects are: Kubli rd., from Missouri flats rd. to the county line, 1.25 miles, \$6,250; Baldwin rd., from Section rd. to Willow Springs, .5 mile, \$5,000; Willow Springs rd., from Baldwin rd. east, one mile, \$15,000; Vilas rd., Hanley rd., 3.76 miles, county's share, \$40,000 (federal government gives matching funds); Grant rd. (guard rail), .23 mile, \$2,100; Pioneer rd., Griffin Creek rd. to Carpenter Hill rd., 1.25 miles, \$27,500; Hyatt Lake rd., 1.5 miles, \$33,000; Upper River rd., 1.69 miles, \$10,200; Elk Creek rd., two miles, \$42,000; Ala Vista rd., 1.75 miles, \$31,000; Poorman Creek rd., .5 mile, \$10,500; and Military rd., .5 mile, \$10,500.

Oiling and paving projects included in the tentative schedule are: Foothill rd., from Coker Butte rd. to Vilas rd., mat coat on 1.25 miles, \$5,625; Corey rd., from McLaughlin rd. to Kershaw rd., mat coat on 1.5 miles, \$6,750;

Kershaw rd., from Corey rd. to Antelope rd., mat coat on .8 mile, \$3,600; Domino and Fowler rds., from Corey to Crater Lake highway, mat coat on .57 mile, \$2,565; Ala Vista rd. (Bigham-Brown rd. to Riley rd.), mat coat on 1.61 miles, \$7,245; Laurel st., in Butte Falls, paving of .12 mile, \$2,520; Butte Falls-Hill-

lake rd., paving three miles, \$29,500; Rogue River drive, paving two miles, \$19,000; Meadows rd., paving 2.85 miles, \$27,400.

Iowa Sandbag Teams Battling Rampaging River

Sandbag teams battled the raging Cedar river in Iowa today under threat of new rains from a tornado-thunderstorm pattern that raked the south-central United States.

Spring's first week and lived up to its promised warmth for most of the nation but warm air melted snow that gorged the Cedar and sent floodwaters racing along the Winnebago, Racoon and Little Sioux rivers in Iowa.

Authorities at Waterloo, Iowa, braced for a predicted 19½-foot crest on the Cedar, 4½ feet over residential flood stage and the highest predicted crest in 32 years.

National Guard troops moved into Mason City, Iowa, and the Red Cross launched emergency operations for 30 families removed ahead of the Winnebago. Other Iowa danger points were at Charles City, Cedar Falls, Cedar Rapids, Sac City and Correctionville.

Mild readings covered most of the nation, with little change from week end warmth that lured Americans by the millions to beaches and forest preserves.

Boy Scouts Found

Tillamook—UP—Four Tillamook Boy Scouts, missing overnight on an outing in the rugged Hebo area about 20 miles south of here, were found Sunday, ending a massive search.

The boys were Michael Bonkowski, 11; Steve Wagner, 12; and Ron Wagner, 11, brothers, and Timothy Jones, 13.

Three firemen from the Mt. Hebo Air Force base, part of 250 searchers, located the youngsters. The boys were described in good condition and sent home.

A sheriff's deputy said the boys told him they spent the night huddled together near an old log after losing their directions.

They had been expected back Saturday night after leaving that afternoon.

Youngster's Body Found at Newport

Newport—UP—A body washed up on the beach near here was identified Sunday as that of a 9-year-old Harrisburg boy crushed by a rolling log and swept out to sea March 15.

Russell Alan Kizer was killed along with his sister, Diane, 13, by the log as they were standing at Hecata beach just north of Florence. The body was found Saturday by a Seal Rock resident about 10 miles south of Newport.

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
