Land Bank Lowers

Land Bank Closes Rate of Interest

Spokane - Effective April 1, the Federal Land Bank of Spokane reduced the rate of interest on its new farm mortgage loans to $5\frac{1}{2}$ per cent, according to Fred A. Knutsen, president.

Knutsen said that present borrowers with loans bearing a 6 per cent interest rate also will benefit from the reduction, and are being notified that, until further notice, the bank will apply the $5\frac{1}{2}$ per cent rate to their loans, commencing April 1.

"This voluntary reduction of $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1 per cent on loans now on the books represents an interest savings at the rate of about \$325,000 annually to 5,500 northwest farmers and ranchers with 6 per cent loans," Knutsen said.

The interest rate reduction, approved at the March meeting of the bank's board of directors, reflects an improvement in the general money situation, according to Knutsen. He said it also reflects the policy of the land bank system to extend credit at the lowest possible cost consistent with sound business practices.
