Help for Persons Suffering Bad Stroke
Dr. Ellison R. Cook III, of Savannah, Georgia, writes in *Modern Medicine* that he has started a clinic for the helping of persons who have had a bad stroke, and for the teaching of people, like wives or daughters who have to take care of such patients. The doctor has a weekly out-patient "stroke clinic." The people who attend, first learn much about how and why strokes come; then they learn about the use of drugs, of physical therapy, perhaps with massage to keep up the strength of the weakened muscles. There will be lessons in restoring the patient's ability to talk; there will be instruction so clearly and simply written that they can read them and there will be talks about the facilities in the community which can help the victim of a stroke.

Any one who has had a bad stroke or who has to take care of such a person ought to read a fine book by Douglas

commentator for the British Broadcasting Corporation, Las Ritchie, called "Stroke" so bad that it took him a long time to learn to talk again. It took him much less time to learn to walk with a cane and a brace, and it took him while to learn to write with his left hand.

Able To Read
Fortunately, he was able to read fairly early after the stroke, but it took him a long time to learn to write. Judging from the quality of the book, he now has fully regained his old ability to write well. He was very fortunate in having a devoted wife who put up with his tantrums and temper which were due to his feelings of frustration and discouragement. She helped him in many ways.
