

### Palm Beach Is Back in Style In Fashions

Palm Beach - (UPI) - For many years Palm Beach originated more men's fashions than perhaps any resort city in the world. Now that President Kennedy has made the world Palm Beach conscious again, the city may repeat.

It usually takes a couple of years for the advanced and sometimes racy styles—bright, hot orange pants, for example—to trickle down to the average man, and by that time the male fashion leaders are off on another tangent.

It takes courage, supreme self assurance and a flair for the dramatic for men to deck themselves out in such gaudy finery, and so it takes a place like Palm Beach to get such fashions started.

Palm Beach remains the home of the rich and the very rich, the social and the very social. And if a wealthy young scion (or a middle-aged one) puts on something daring and different he operates in the sure knowledge the less assured will run out and copy it.

Actually it is the men's stores on fashionable Worth ave. that dream up the new styles and all the rich young playboy has to do is drop in, see for himself what is daring and different, to buy and start the fashion wheels rolling.

One of those stores is Stinchfield's, where you can find the most sedate clothes in the world or some of the wildest. They helped launch the outbreak of madras a few years back, but now they've tamed it.

Nino Polz, the star salesman who pads around the shop in the latest shorts and shirts, bare-legged and with no socks, predicts big successes for drip dry oxford jackets in such improbable colors as ecru, lime, sky blue and brooks pink. There are matching shorts, but there also are subdued madras shirts to go with the wild colored slacks.

There is a new crew shirt with no collar - just an old-fashioned neckband with three buttons making it possible to slip over the head.

And in the trousers department, Stinchfield has combined the no-pleat Ivy League look with the old-fashioned buttoned pants to make pants with a pleat on each side. That's because by the time the male fashion leaders have developed enough aplomb to set styles they also have developed a bit of a paunch.

A few blocks down Worth is Schur's, a place so elegant it looks like a fashionable man's club in London. The salesmen there are almost as subdued and clad in the most popular numbers. In this case a double-breasted four button blue blazer and white flannel pants. For the blazer there are solid gold buttons at \$125 a set or gold plated for \$25.

Big Seller. But the big seller there is bright colored pants (and matching shirts). They are pin-wale corduroy in hot orange, brilliant green, gold, sky blue and lime. The matching shirts are loose fitting alpacas with three-quarter inch sleeves. They can be seen for miles.

A couple of other style notes: The rage at the moment is plain brown loafers worn without socks with shorts and slacks, occasional rope-soled espadrille (which skid on boat decks) and Japanese sandals held on by the big toe. Black dinner jackets with the "continental" look - no satin lapels but just satin facing on the lapels, sleeves and pockets.

Special Cachet Is Planned from Ship

Washington, D.C.—A special cachet, "First Icebreaker Around the World," will be issued on special mail from the Coast Guard Cutter Eastwind, which is en route home after 70 days in Antarctic waters.

Persons wishing to include mail in the special cachet should air-mail addressed envelopes to the Postal Clerk, CGC Eastwind, (WAGB-279) care of Fleet Post Office, New York, N. Y. Envelopes will be limited to three per person, and must arrive at the Fleet Post Office not later than May 8.

The 289-foot icebreaker is homeward bound for Boston, Mass., after taking part in Deepfreeze '81 operation. It departed Boston Oct. 25, 1980, via the Panama Canal and arrived at McMurdo Sound, Antarctica, Dec. 20. Ports of call for the remainder of the around-the-world journey included Australia, Colombo, through the Suez Canal to Greece, Italy and Portugal. The ship will arrive in Boston the end of May.
