

Resolution Reviews Reasons New Site For Building Asked

In a resolution sent Friday to Oregon's Congressional delegation and to officials of the general services administration, the Medford city planning commission strongly urges the federal government to erect its new \$2 1/2 million building in the city's proposed civic center.

The resolution was unanimously adopted by the commission at its Thursday night meeting after Commission President Jack Edson said their might still be a hope that the government would locate the building in the civic center.

The general services administration had earlier announced that the building would be located between Central and Riverside aves. south of 10th st. Most city officials had expressed disappointment with this decision.

The president and past president of the Medford Chamber of Commerce share the feelings of the planning commission, and Friday they sent a telegram to Congressman Edwin R. Durno asking that the federal building be located in the civic center.

Whereas the planning commission of the city of Medford is charged, by law and by the city council, with the primary responsibility for planning and orderly development of land use within the boundaries of the city of Medford, Oregon; and

Whereas the city of Medford, Oregon, has had on file since 1931 a proposed plan setting aside a certain area within said city as a civic center for the location and grouping of public buildings; and

Whereas the planning commission has been requested to advise the city council on the proposed location of the federal building; and

Whereas the planning commission is informed and so believes that the general services administration intends to locate the new federal building in an area outside of the civic center, and at a location which, from a sound planning

basis, is objectionable to the planning commission in that the location would create unnecessary traffic congestion, would not accommodate adequate off-street parking, preclude further development and extension of 11th st. and directly conflicts with the generalized land use plan prepared for the city; and

Whereas to locate the new federal building in the proposed civic center would coincide with the generalized land use plan for the city, and that there is now located in the proposed civic center the Jackson county courthouse, public library and the West-side park, all of which were located pursuant to the 1931 plan for the civic center; and that a federal building is and should be an integral part of the civic center; and

Whereas in the interest of orderly development, sound planning, a need for additional public buildings, and sustenance of property values in the city, the federal building should be located in the civic center.

Be it resolved by the planning commission:

That the members of Congress representing the State of Oregon are hereby urged to direct their influence to the effect that the federal building be located in the proposed civic center.

That the general services administration is hereby urged to locate the federal building in the proposed civic center.

That the city of Medford is hereby urged to plan and develop the civic center in accordance with the plan on file with the city council.
