The Medical Roundup

A Nervous Cough
I learned a lot recently as, in a railroad station, I sat beside a nice woman, her boy

of six, and her infant in arms. Every few minutes the boy would cough in a dry, hacking way—obviously, doing it on purpose—and then he would say to his mother, "Didn't you hear me coughing; what are you going to do for me?" When the mother just smiled, the boy went into a choking spell. Again, he turned to his quiet mother and asked, "Aren't you going to do something for me?" And, again, she just smiled.

I asked her, "How long has he been doing this?" And she said, "Three months; he started when I came home from the hospital with the baby. Before that he had always insisted on being the center of attention. Now he is trying harder than ever to be the whole show. Sometimes he holds his breath until he turns blue, and sometimes he sort of stutters. I know so well what he is trying to do that I just smile at him, but sometimes I cuddle him a bit to show him that I still love him dearly."

I said, "How very fortunate that he has so wise and self-controlled a mother as you are. A mother who would go into spasms of anxiety over his antics could quickly make a hysterical wreck out of him." "Well," she said, "most of the credit must go to my dear old doctor who sized up the situation the minute he saw it and told me never to show any alarm. As he said, 'when a hysterical person loses his audience he soon quits putting on his show.'"

Bee Stings for Arthritis
People keep asking me why we doctors do not get bees to sting the joints of people with arthritis. They think this is something new. Actually, I heard of it the first time in 1905, when I was an intern in a big City Hospital. Some doctors then sent their patients to be treated by a bee man, while others injected formic acid hypodermically, around the affected joints. A good Chief gave the method a cold trial, and because he saw no results, he eventually gave it up. Now I read that in Europe bees are again being made to sting patients with arthritis.

What interests me most is that enthusiasm for treatments like this keeps showing up at intervals. Then many people think the stunt is new. I would not be surprised if they used bee-stings for arthritis thousands of years before Christ. What happens is that when a sufferer from arthritis gets stung by some bees, and his arthritis clears up, he feels he has found a cure.

The only trouble is that when 10 people try it, perhaps one gets helped. A good example of an old folk remedy that today is being regarded as a great new discovery is that of boiled and concentrated sea water. I see no reason why it should do anything for anyone, but for the next six months thousands of people will be trying it.

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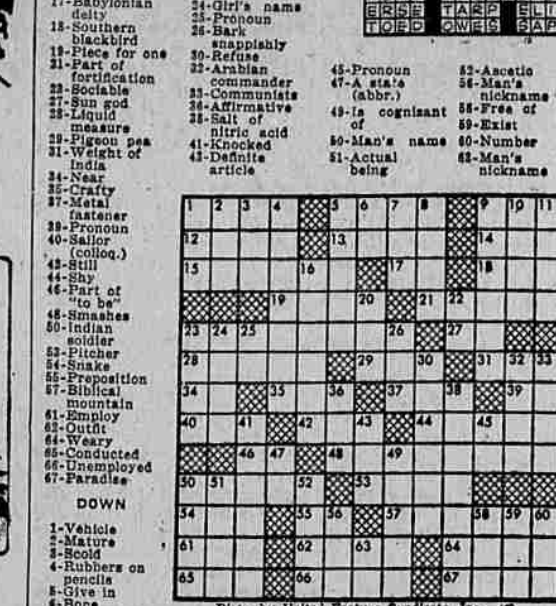
