NOTICE OF SCHOOL ELECTION UPON QUESTION OF INCREASING TAX LEVY OVER AMOUNT LIMITED BY SECTION 11, ARTICLE XI, STATE CONSTITUTION
 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held in School District No. 94 of Jackson County, State of Oregon, from 2:30 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. on May 1, 1961, at Pinehurst School in said school district, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said district the question of increasing the tax levy for the fiscal year 1961-1962 over the amount limited by section 11, article XI, of the Constitution of Oregon.

The reasons for increasing such tax are:

1. School District No. 94 has no tax base, therefore it is necessary to vote the entire levy.

2. The amount of tax in excess of the 6% limitation, proposed to be levied for said fiscal year is \$14,702.14.

NOTICE TO CONCESSIONERS
 Sealed proposals, for sales privileges at Emigrant Reservoir Recreation Area, Jackson County, Oregon, will be received by the Jackson County Board of Commissioners, at the County Courthouse, Medford, Oregon, at 10:00 a.m. on April 26, 1961, for a 12-month Sales Privilege Permit. The Permit consists of the exclusive right and privilege to operate a mobile type store facility within the recreation area for the sale to the general public at reasonable prices, such items as milk, cream, bread, pastry, ice, ice cream, soft drinks, and such other dairy products, food staples, confections, service, gasoline and oil for boats and automobiles, boats, boat motors and accessories for boats, fishing equipment, and towing service for boat trailers or other items as may be permitted by the Permit.

Proposals, copies of Sales Privilege Permit Agreement and all information for proposers may be obtained at the office of the County Clerk, County Courthouse, Medford, Oregon.

Proposals must be submitted on a proposal form obtained from the County Clerk Office and must be accompanied by a cash bond or a certified check in the amount of at least \$100.00.

The successful proposer will be required to furnish a bond or deposit in the amount of \$300.00.
