**PT&T Committed To
Avoid Rate Boosts**

Olympia, Wash.—UPI—Hearings on an application to form a new telephone company to serve Washington, Oregon and Idaho concluded Wednesday with a 10-year commitment by Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Co. to avoid rate increases solely as a result of higher debt interest rates.

The California corporation, which will turn over its assets to the newly created Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Co., also must submit more detailed information to the Washington Public Service Commission "as soon as possible" before final determination will be made.

Similar hearings began today in Salem, Ore., on the requested transfer of stock in the largest utility in the Northwest.

**Boeing Engineers
Tell Water Needs**

Pendleton—UPI—Boeing Airplane Co. of Seattle will need 500 gallons of water a minute at the Boardman space age site, Boeing civil engineers said Wednesday.

Donald Lester and Tex Allen of the aero space division of Boeing also said a one million gallon storage facility would be needed.

They spoke to Eastern Oregon water well drillers and called for bids within a week. Most of the water will be used as a coolant for flame deflectors, which are used in the ground testing of rocket engines, Allen said. The firm also will need the water for fire protection.
