"Well, that call must have made the old man happy," the banker replied.

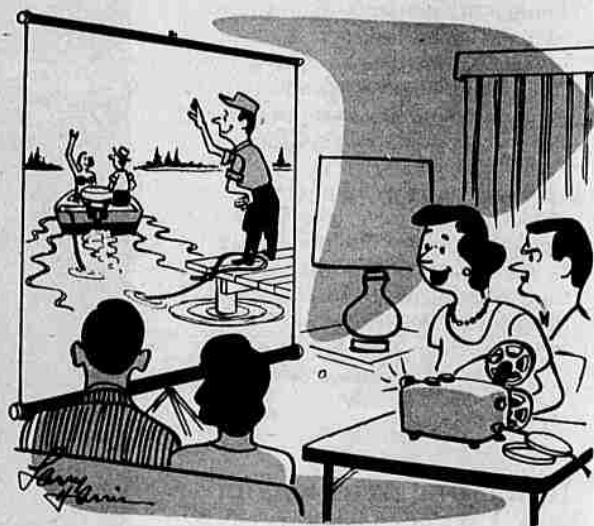
