Emphysema

Hundreds of people keep asking me about emphysema: what it is, and what can be done for it.

One of the main troubles in emphysema is that many of the thousands of tiny air sacs in the lungs either dilate or rupture, one into the other.

In this process the area of the surface exposed to the air is much lessened, and this makes the lungs less efficient for their job of taking oxygen out of the air and putting it into the blood.

Often, also, the elasticity of the lungs is impaired and, as a result, when the patient takes in a breath, he cannot get it out easily again. In the process, the lungs often get widely expanded, and the diaphragm or midriff which does so much of the bellows-like work of the chest wall, gets down as far as it will go and then stays there. One can easily see this by taking a flash light and holding it near the lower ribs on the side. In a normal person, with each breath, one can see the midriff peeling away from the chest wall, but in an emphysematous person, one sees that it hardly moves at all.

Diagnosis From Glance
One can often diagnose emphysema from a glance at the patient. He may have a round, instead of an oval chest, and it can be seen that he has very little chest expansion. Tests with a spirometer also will show in a minute how little air goes in and out of him with each breath. Often he is a bit wheezy, and asthmatic, and the two muscles in the front of his neck, which raise his

ribs and thereby help the air to go into his lungs always are contracted. Often I make the diagnosis just by looking at the man's pinched and anxious face. For a long time he has had to make an effort to take each breath. A glance at his fingers may show that they are "spade-shaped" at the ends, which means that, for long, his lungs have been in trouble.

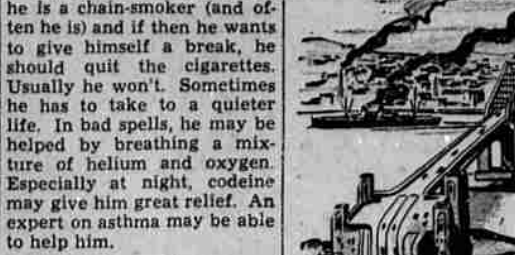
Also, I can make the diagnosis of emphysema from a glance at the man's lungs as they show up in an x-ray film. The shadows are too black, which means the lungs are abnormally full of air. Sometimes an emphysematous man has a bluish red color to his skin, produced by the excess of hemoglobin or red pigment in his blood. Such a man may have an excessive number of red blood cells. This excess of blood is the reverse of anemia is designed to make up for the poor aeration of the blood in the man's defective lungs.

Another Handicap
After some years the emphysematous man gets another handicap—the right side of his heart, which pumps blood through his lungs, tends gradually to fail under the added strain. Another difficulty is that the dilated and torn air sacs tend to get infected every so often, as when the man has a cold; and sometimes then the infection is hard to clear up. The person may be subject to bronchitis and on an occasional patch of broncho-pneumonia. Much coughing, naturally, is bad for the man because it causes more dilation of his air sacs.

Usually, after a while, the man becomes a sufferer from what looks like asthma. As one would expect, the disease tends to become worse around the age of 45, and because it is a degenerative disease; it
