Have the car checked, pack a grip.*

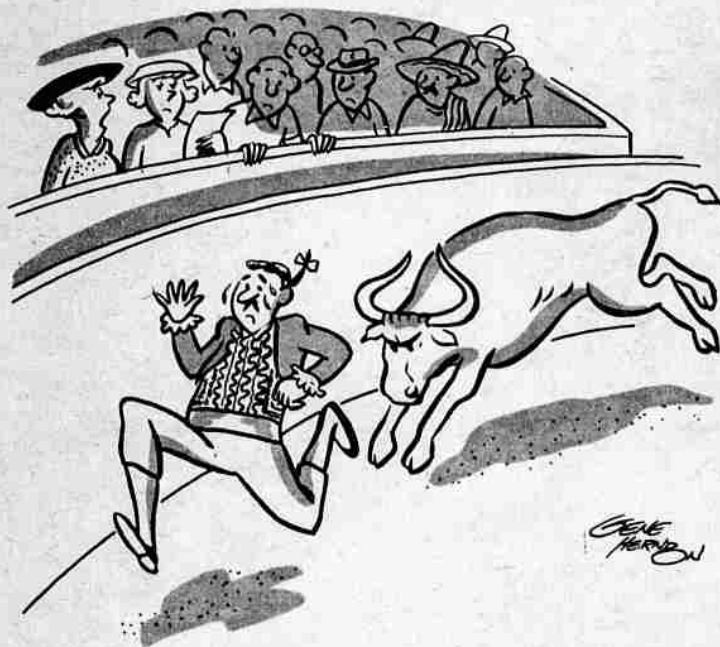
