Unofficial Fast Time in Astoria

Astoria—UPB—The move to unofficial daylight saving time in the Astoria area continued today. Most Astoria businesses and schools have been operating an hour earlier to conform with daylight time in the Portland area. Seaside officials said they planned to open businesses an hour earlier starting May 13. The Astoria - Megler ferry plans to change to unofficial daylight hours Wednesday morning. The Warrenton school board Monday night also decided to open schools an hour earlier.

Thorton To Attend Washington Parley

Salem — UPB — Atty. Gen. Robert Y. Thorton said he will go to Washington, D.C., in a week or 10 days for a pre-trial conference on the state's suit which seeks to reverse the order moving Northwest region post office headquarters from Portland to Seattle. The move has been accomplished. But Thorton's suit would reverse the order and require the facilities to be moved back to Portland. Thorton said he expects the case to come up within two months.

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Russians Increase Bering Sea Fleet

Washington—UPI—Sen. Warren G. Magnuson said Tuesday he had learned the Russians have increased their Bering Sea fishing fleet this year and done exploratory work south of the Aleutian Islands. Magnuson said he received the information from Donald L. McKernan, director of the Bureau of Commercial Fisheries, during a Senate Commerce committee hearing on the agency's fiscal 1962 budget request. The senator questioned McKernan regarding fish taken by the Russians in the Bering Sea and was told that bottom fish and king crab comprised most of the catch.
