Duilio Loi Convincing

Milan, Italy—UPI—At 32, Italian Duilio Loi at last is a genuine hero in his homeland because of his convincing defense of the world junior welterweight championship Wednesday night in his third title fight with Carlos Ortiz of New York.

The 40,000 fans in cold, wind-swept San Siro Stadium cheered wildly the stocky, black-haired restaurant proprietor from Trieste when referee Frank Carter of California raised Duilio's hand in victory at the end of 15 rounds.

It was a much more impressive triumph than that of last Sept. 1, when Duilio won the 140-pound crown by also outpointing Ortiz in the same ring. That bout had been much closer.

Wednesday night Loi, who weighed 138 pounds to Carlos' 137, not only gave the New Yorker a boxing lesson but had him on the floor and hurt in the sixth round. Duilio completely captivated the top-coated fans in the 15th when he in turn was floored by a right to the chin but bounced right up again and motioned that it was only a slip.

OSU Leading Candidate In Baseball

Berkeley, Calif.—UPI—USC, Fresno State and Oregon State are leading candidates to represent the West at the college baseball world series next month, but several other schools still have an outside chance at the honor, according to Stanford coach Dutch Fehring.

Fehring, NCAA District Eight tournament chairman Wednesday named chief candidates for the four spots in the district tourney.

One berth automatically goes to the CIBA champion. The number one nationally-ranked USC Trojans, who own a strong 33-6-1 season record, have almost clinched this league title. Runnerup California must win six straight while the Trojans lose two out of three. USC was runnerup in the national tourney last year.

The at-large berth is almost certain to go to Fresno State, who is 32-6 on the year and 14-1 in the CCAA race. Second place San Diego State has a mathematical chance to overtake the Bulldogs, but

Members of the girls team are Mary Kay Harris and Nancy Hinman, who'll be No. 1 and 2 entrants in singles, and Linda Hess and Sandy

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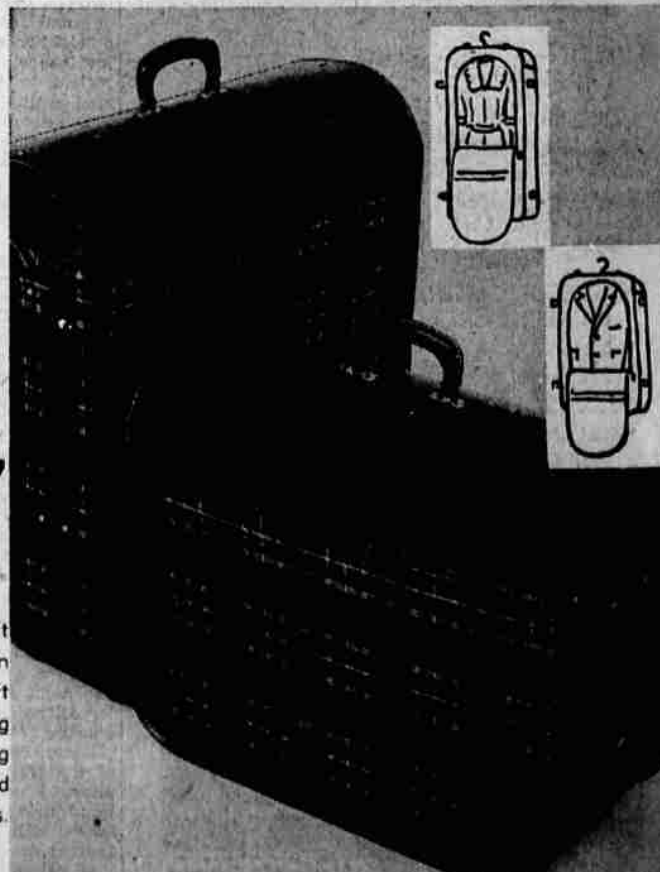
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
