

10 Per Cent of Kennedy Program Already Enacted

Washington - (CQ) - How the President Kennedy's program faring in Congress? To attempt to arrive at a factual answer, Congressional Quarterly compiled all of the President's specific legislative requests made since he took office and counted those which Congress had enacted, as of May 5. The findings: Requests: 277. Approved: 28. This works out to approval of 10 per cent of the President's requests, and it's a high score for this point in a Congressional session.

A mid-session 1957 Eisenhower box score shows that a Democratic Congress approved 6.6 per cent of the former Republican President's legislative requests during the first session of his second term. At that time Eisenhower had made 193 requests and only 13 per cent of the 193 requests gained final approval. In 1960 Eisenhower had his 30 per cent of the 193 requests gained final approval. The fact of lame-duck presidency and Congressional involvement in civil rights debate may have been largely responsible for the low batting average. And, in an election year, a Congress and a White House held by different parties didn't help.

The Democratic Congress was most generous to Eisenhower's legislative program in the recession year of 1958. It gave him 47 per cent of 284 requests.

Kennedy's mid-session total of 277 requests this year is 41 more than Eisenhower ever made in an entire session. Congress has taken action

on some sort on 178 of the President's requests. The overall status of the 277 as of May 5:

29 - or 10 per cent - have been approved by both the House and Senate and are law or awaiting Kennedy's signature.

28 - or 9 per cent - have passed one chamber.

8 or 3 per cent - have been reported from committees to the floor but have not yet come up for a vote in either chamber.

105 - 38 per cent - have undergone committee hearings but haven't been reported.

9 - 3 per cent - have been rejected in committee or on the floor but can be brought up again.

38 per cent - was a financing measure in the already signed temporary extended unemployment compensation bill which was dropped and won't be brought up again.

99 - 36 per cent - have received no action at all in either chamber.

Many of the requests were embodied in the President's 16 "priority" bills, 8 of which have already been approved by Congress.

Twenty-three of the 29 requests which have been approved so far were contained in these priority measures: feed grains, minimum wage, depressed areas, judgeships, Reconstruction Act, temporary extension of unemployment compensation, aid to dependent children, and ratification of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development treaty.

Other approved requests include reinstatement of Eisenhower as a five-star general, a measure to help alleviate the balance of payments problem, and several special appropriations.

Major areas so far untouched: foreign aid appropriations, which must be reckoned with during the current session; medical care for the aging under Social Security, which appears stalled in the House Ways and Means committee. (Copyright 1961, Congressional Quarterly, Inc.)

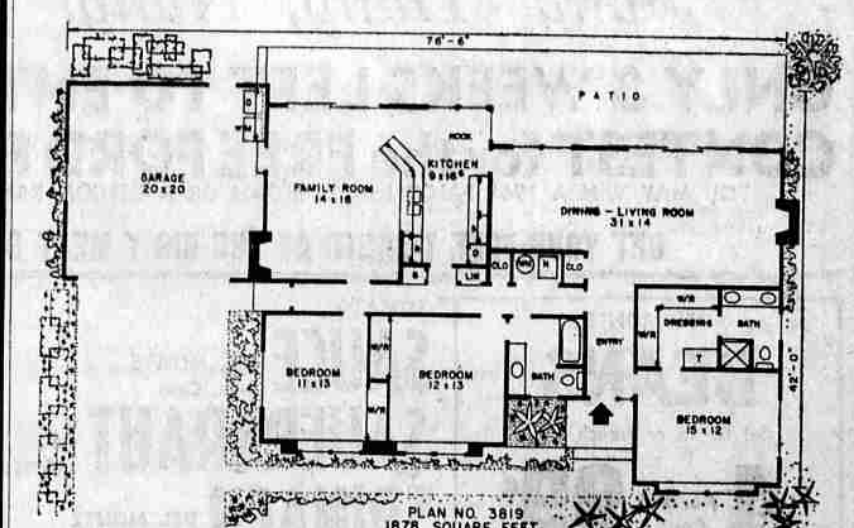
