Red China Moves To Bolster Lack Of Food Supplies

Tokyo — (UPI) — Communist Chinese leaders today were reported using capitalistic practices to bolster farm production on the food-short China mainland.

Authoritative reports reaching Tokyo from Red China said the Peiping regime hoped to save the rural people's commune system from collapsing.

The key developments cited were the establishment of rural trade fairs with limited free enterprise, and the development of so-called "family side line occupations" and cultivation of private farm plots.

Heated Discussion

The reports appeared in the Ta Kung Pao newspaper, the leading economic daily of Communist China, and other publications. They indicated there was much heated discussion among Communist party officials and economists on the "objective necessity" for permitting such practices. The Chinese mainland has been hit in the past year by drastic food shortages which have reached famine proportions in some areas. The Peiping government has been forced to buy grain from several Western nations.

Failures Indicated

Chinese leaders have attributed the shortages to floods, droughts and other "natural calamities," but there have been indications of failures in the communes. Under the commune system, the rural population is regimented into large farm centers to work on common projects for the state.

The reports from the mainland indicated that free enterprise would be permitted as long as it did not get out of hand.

Motion Picture Director Dies

North Hollywood, Calif. — (UPI) — Director Michael Curtiz, who created such stars as Joan Crawford, Errol Flynn, Doris Day and Ann Blythe and won an Academy Award in 1943 for "Casablanca," died Wednesday of cancer.

The Hungarian-born Curtiz was noted in the film industry for haunting juvenile courts, pawn shops, jails, slums, museums and concerts in an effort to make his movies more accurate for the American scene.

Warner Bros. Studio president Jack Warner, Curtiz's first employer when he came to the United States in 1927, praised the talented director as "one of the very great directors in the motion picture industry."

Curtiz, whose recent pictures include "The Commanders" and "St. Francis of Assisi," also directed the Academy Award-winning picture "Mildred Pierce" in 1945.

'Cosmonauts Day' Observed in Russia

Moscow — (UPI) — The Soviet Union today celebrated "Cosmonauts Day" marking the first anniversary of Yuri Gagarin's pioneer flight into space.

There was no advance indication that the Russians intended to use the occasion for any new spectacular space effort.

The nationwide celebrations were expected to reach a climax at a reception in the Kremlin. It was possible that Soviet Premier Nikita S. Khrushchev would make his first public appearance since he came down with influenza last week.

For several days, meetings have been held throughout the country to kindle enthusiasm for the celebrations. The Presidium of the Supreme Soviet (parliament) has decreed that April 12 henceforth will be observed annually as Cosmonauts Day.

Radar-Gard Signals To Speeding Driver

Chicago — (UPI) — Can you beat police radar?

Motorists have tried by filling their auto hubcaps with tin foil and dragging so-called static belts along the pavement. Neither works, says a Chicago manufacturer who advises better driving practices as the way to beat radar.

To help drivers avoid radar traps, the manufacturer is marketing an electronic device which detects radar signals and warns the driver he is speeding. The device, called Radar-Gard, emits a buzzing sound until an automobile goes over a prescribed speed-radar or no radar.
