Keglers Vie In Masters Tournament

Des Moines, Iowa-UPI-Some of the nation's top bowlers will go to the line here Saturday to launch a five-day drive for one of the richest purses in the 12-year history of the American Bowling Congress' Masters tournament.

The qualifying group of 480 will be pared to 48 Saturday and Sunday. They will join eight exempt bowlers and eight state representatives for the double-elimination match game championships which will run through day and night sessions Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

A record prize fund of \$19,320 will be awarded, including \$3,000 to the champion. The top prize exceeds \$2,500 which defending champion Don Carter, St. Louis, Mo., received last year.

Carter and three other former Masters champions are among the eight exempt from the two days of qualifying trials.

Other former champions are Billy Gombelowski, Detroit, and Ray Bluth and Tom Hennessey, both of St. Louis. Also exempt from qualifying trials are Dick Weber, St. Louis, the 1961 bowler of the year; Eddie Lubanski, Detroit, current ABC 10-year average leader; Bob Brayman, Detroit, 1961 Classic division all-events champion; and Luke Karan, Detroit, 1961 regular division all-events champion.

Of the team, Kerr is the oldest at 24. He came to Portland at the suggestion of an ex-Pilot player. Kerr has a fine variety of shots and is a consistent pointmaker.

Omar Pabst, 22, is captain of the team and ranks as one of the top collegiate players now in this country. He has been Pilot No. 1 for three years. His regular season record for that time is 50-2. Including last summer's CCAA play he is 51-3 for his Pilot career.

Ernest Pabst is now a strong No. 2 with a 23-5 two-season mark. In 1960 he won the Chilean national tournament and teamed with Becerra for the doubles crown. Becerra also plays on the Portland soccer team. Silva is a new-comer to the squad.

Ducks, Beavers State Saturday Cinder Rivals

United Press International Oregon's high-flying Ducks and the powerful Oregon State Beavers will face tough track tests Saturday.

The Ducks take on Stanford in a dual meet at Eugene and the Beavers battle Fresno State and California in a triangular meet at Berkeley, Calif.

Oregon and Oregon State are favored although both are expected to receive strong opposition.

The Ducks also will be tuning up for their dual meet at Los Angeles April 21 against defending NCAA champion Southern California.

Burleson Two-Mile Highlight

University of Oregon, Eugene-A quartet of athletes assumed undisputed leaderships and five more moved into Northern Division track and field rankings as the result of action last week.

Highlight of last week's activity was Dyrrol Burleson's record breaking 8:42.5 two-mile effort. The Oregon star shattered the national collegiate and American citizen records in grabbing the top spot in that event among Northwest leaders.

Other new leaders are Lynn Eves of Oregon State, Oregon high jumper Terry Llewellyn and Oregon broad jumper Jerry Close. Eves was clocked in 46.7 in the 440-yard dash last week to add a first place ranking in that event to his share of the 220 lead and second place rating in the 100.

Llewellyn broke away from a previous tie with Hank Wyborne of Washington State in the high jump by clearing 6-8 as the Ducks swamped Brigham Young and Close jumped 24 feet 1 1/2 inch to tie for the best effort in the broad jump with Dave Kerrone of WSU.

Five more efforts recorded over the week-end were good enough to break into the top three list. Oregon's Keith Forman took over third in the mile with a 4:07.3. The Duck's Veevee grabbed second in the two-mile with a flashy 8:52.5. Oregon's Mike Gaechter moved into a tie for second place in the low hurdles with a 24.1. Oregon State's Jim Roehm landed third place in the broad jump with a leap of 23-7 1/2. Oregon's Ron Gomez threw the javelin 223 feet for third place in that event.

Oregon maintained its domination of the rankings, boasting the top performer in 11 events and sharing the top spot in two others. Oregon State leads the way in three events, Washington and Washington State in one event each, and the Beavers and Cougars each share one top billing.
