Indian Ancestors Traced Back About 11,000 Years Ago

Eugene — The ancient peoples of Oregon, ancestors of the Indians who were living along the Columbia and southward when Lewis and Clark came in 1805, were residents of the Northwest about 11,000 years ago.

It is the story of these ancient people that Dr. Luther S. Cressman, head of the anthropology department at the University of Oregon, tells in a book published by the Champoeg Press for Beaver Books of Portland. Title of the book is "The Sandals and the Cave."

The volume derives its name from the sandals of woven sage-brush bark discovered by Cressman and his associates in 1938 in a cave of Fort Rock, northeast of the Klamath lake region of south central Oregon.

Uncovered Under Ashes

The sandals, some 75 of them, were uncovered under layers of the volcanic ash and debris that had turned the one-time lake region into a desolate desert region. Age of these ancient artifacts has been determined as 9,000 years old.

Dorothy O. Johansen of Portland, who, with Constance Bordwell of the University of Oregon, edited the book, explains in the foreword, that the new paperback volume is "a brief but comprehensive description of the cultures of Indians in Oregon." It is, as well, an introduction to the work of cultural anthropologists and archaeologists.

"The Sandals and the Cave" is the product of Anthropologist Cressman's life work and of the understanding of people generally which has evolved from his work.

In the author's preface, Cressman writes that he has tried to show the nature of culture, how it organizes the lives of people who share it; and how it "works" and gives meaning to experience.

An important and significant facet of the cultures of the Indians of Oregon was the slow pace of development. These cultures, based on stone tools, remained, over the centuries, simple hunting and gathering economies.

Isolated from the growing civilizations of the Old World and from the developments of the New World in Central and South America, Oregon's first residents remained in a fairly constant and primitive state until the arrival of the pioneers of the last century, who brought with them "civilization" and disaster.

Dr. Cressman, a member of the University of Oregon faculty since 1929, has devoted much of his career to research on the origins and cultures of the Indians of the region.

Airman Confesses Slaying in Idaho

Mountain Home, Idaho—(UPI)—Airmen 1-C Gerald M. Anderson was in custody today in connection with the slaying of a week ago of Mrs. Nancy Joy Johnson.

Anderson was arrested Thursday and charged with first-degree murder. He denied having any part in the death of her son, Daniel, 2.

Anderson, 24, formerly of San Diego, Calif., is an aircraft mechanic. He signed a statement, Prosecutor Frank Hicks said, admitting the slaying of Mrs. Johnson.

Bodies of the mother and son were found in their home.

Bullet Fired Into Justice Sloan's Office

Salem — (UPI)—Police are still looking for the bullet which was fired into the office of Justice Gordon Sloan in the Oregon Supreme Court building here Thursday night.

No one was in the third floor office, but the shot broke a window and creased a davenport. Who fired the shot and why remains a mystery.

Investigators believe the bullet may be lodged in the ceiling.

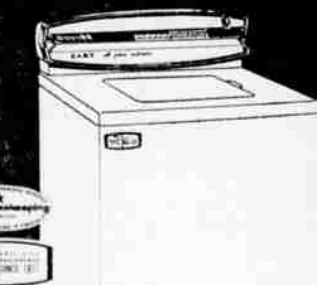
Gasoline Price War Spreads in Oregon
