

Area Students in Honors Program

Corvallis — Seven students from the Medford area are in the school of science honors program at Oregon State University.

The Science Honors program was started two years ago to "enrich educational opportunities for the more able students and to recognize scholarly achievement."

A total of 68 freshmen, 54 sophomores, 24 juniors, and 19 seniors are participating in the special program this year. Under the program, students are enrolled in honors sections in several departments, do extra work such as special readings, research and seminars, and take some special classes throughout their college careers. At graduation, they receive diplomas that indicate honors in their specific fields.
