Wilmington, Del. — Attorney Chester C. Davis, declaring there was little chance missing millionaire Howard Hughes would come out of hiding to accept a government subpoena: "He's an independent man."

New Orleans, La. — New Orleans city Atty. Alvin J. Liska, in asking a federal court that the city be allowed to intervene as a defendant with the school board in its attempt to halt scheduled school desegregation:

Peace Corps Tests Scheduled April 21

Peace Corps placement tests will be given Saturday, April 21, in civil service commission testing centers throughout the country. All tests will begin at 8:30 a.m.

The Peace Corps test centers located near Medford are in Klamath Falls and Roseburg. In Klamath Falls the center is located in the post office building, and the Roseburg center is in room 203 in the federal building.

Questionnaires are available at post offices. Interested persons who have not yet filled out questionnaires will be permitted to take the tests and will be accommodated on a "space available" basis.

80 Acres of Park Site Leased by BLM To State of Oregon

Portland — The bureau of land management is leasing 80 acres of O and C forest lands at the confluence of the East and West Forks of the Illinois river to the state of Oregon for public recreation development. BLM State Director Russell E. Getty announced today.

The lands in Josephine county, adjacent to Highway 199, are suited to camping, picnicking, swimming, and general public recreation use. Getty said the area will be called Illinois Fork State Park. The state parks division of the Oregon highway commission is planning, geology, and physical education.

An applicant must be an American citizen and at least 18 years. There is no upper age limit. Married couples without dependent children may apply, providing both qualify.

mission plans a \$45,000 recreation development on the tract. Facilities will include a water system, drinking fountains, access road and parking area, sanitary facilities, picnic tables, camp stoves, swimming beach, and foot paths.

Getty said public lands will be leased to the state at a nominal rate of 25 cents an acre. The department of the interior has set this low rate to aid state and local governments in developing public recreational facilities. BLM will continue to manage the surface and mineral resources of the tract consistent with its recreational use.

The Illinois river is a favorite fishing stream in Josephine county. Areas adjacent to the public land tract being leased by BLM are in private ownership, and are not available for general public recreation use. Therefore, the BLM tract will help satisfy the outdoor recreation needs of the local population and also will

be available to the general public traveling over the Redwood Highway, Getty noted.

In order for the state to lease the lands for 25 cents an acre they had to submit a comprehensive development program for BLM's approval. They have also guaranteed that the park development will be open to the general public without discrimination. Should these provisions not be followed, the lands would revert to the federal government.

BLM is developing many public recreation sites in western Oregon. The sites developed and maintained by the bureau are generally of regional or national significance. Getty said that the bureau has now completed 25 public recreation developments in western Oregon.

Glenn Not Able to Attend Rose Festival

Washington — (UPI) — Astronaut John Glenn will not be able to attend the June Rose Festival in Portland, according to Rep. Walter Norblad (R-Ore.) who had invited the Marine colonel.

A similar invitation to Lt. Dee O'Hara, of Crabtree, Ore., nurse for the astronauts, has been forwarded to the Air Force.

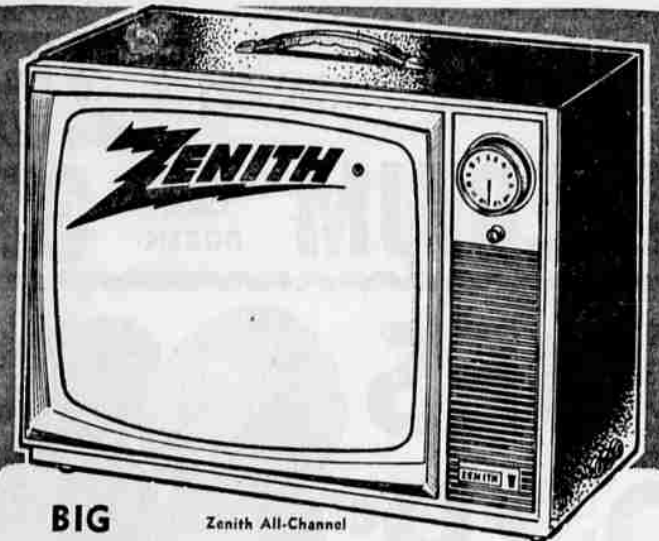
OLDSTER DIES
Alicante, Spain — (UPI) — Juan Ortega Villarin, believed to be one of the oldest persons in Spain, died Wednesday night at the age of 112.

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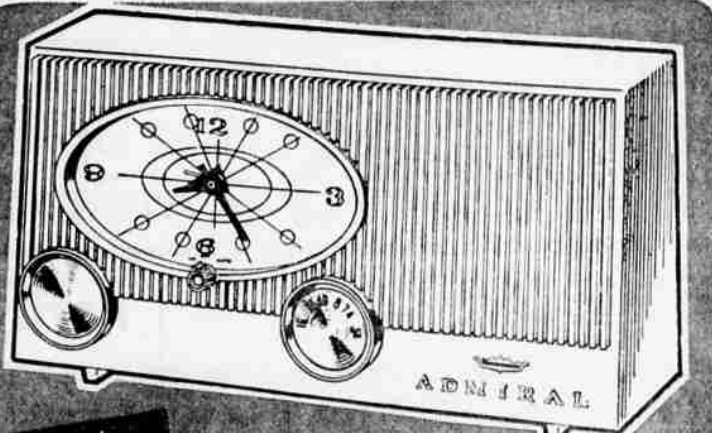
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
