Len Casanova to Speak at Banquet

and Future" will be the subject of an address by University of Oregon's head football coach, Leonard J. (Len) Casanova, when he appears as speaker at the kickoff banquet at Rogue Valley Country club Friday, April 27, at 7 p.m.

The event will mark the opening of the public phase of St. Mary's Endowment Fund Program.

Dr. Arnold M. Depner, chairman, said that all endowment fund organization members and volunteer workers for the public phase program are invited to attend. Joe Naumes will act as master of ceremonies, and musical entertainment will be provided.

The endowment fund program has been launched, according to Dr. Depner, not only to provide funds for clearing the remaining debt on the construction of the new St. Mary's High school on Black Oak dr., but to establish a revolving fund to handle the building of additional classrooms and other needed facilities for both grade and high school.

The high school, built at a cost of \$265,000 and with a present enrollment of 200 students, will, it is said, save local taxpayers \$100,000 a year, in addition to the tax saving of \$25,000 by the maintenance of St. Mary's Elementary school.
