

Redskin Owner To Seek Draft Delay

Washington—(UPI)—Owner George Preston Marshall of the Washington Redskins said today he will ask the National Football League to delay future drafting of college players until after January 1.

The NFL's most outspoken owner called any drafting before players complete their college football eligibility "simply bribing boys to violate their responsibilities to their schools."

Marshall said he would introduce a resolution banning any before-January 1 draft at the next league meeting in May. He added that he has the support of several other NFL owners.

The Redskins recently lost some of their top draft choices to teams in the American Football league. In each case, Washington approached the players after their college eligibility was over and found they already had been signed by AFL clubs. But Marshall said he was not worried over the possibility that a late NFL draft would give the rival circuit first crack at outstanding college stars.

"We should clean our own house," GPM declared. "I don't give a hoot what the AFL or Canadian leagues do. I'm asking our own league to do what is sound, logical and decent."

Marshall said he would take up a resolution after the first of the year when all bowl games have been concluded was "obviously sen-

sible from the standpoint of the pro coaches.

"It would give our coaches an opportunity to draft with more time and more intelligence," he said. "The bowl games provide an excellent line on college stars."

GPM denounced early drafting as "a corrupt policy."

"The NFL should be big enough and strong enough not to interfere with college players before their eligibility is up," he asserted. "We should be able to go to the schools with clean hands."

Warriors May Move

New York—(UPI)—The possible transfer of the Philadelphia Warriors to San Francisco and the establishment of a new franchise in Baltimore will be discussed today at the annual meeting of the National Basketball Association's board of governors.

No final decision is expected today on either issue because several members of the board have other urgent business and will be unable to remain in New York more than 24 hours. A hearing of financial reports and basic plans for next year's schedule are also on the agenda.

Owner Eddie Gottlieb of the Warriors is expected to tell the board that he has received an \$850,000 offer to sell the franchise to San Francisco.

The owners will take up a discussion of the new franchise in Baltimore, which they have been considering since their January meeting.

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California Loop To Open Tonight

The far-flung class C California League, now stretching from Santa Barbara in the south 600 miles north to Reno, Nev., opens 1962 operations tonight with hopes high for both an artistic and financial success.

The first-night games send defending champion Reno to Santa Barbara; Stockton at Modesto; Bakersfield at San Jose and Fresno at Visalia.

"With the league expanded to eight teams," said President Eddie Mulligan, "we are expecting our best season in years. The advance sale of tickets has been up in all cities. Sale of advertising on the fences has been wonderful."

The new teams are the San Jose Bees and the Santa Barbara Rancheros.

Ticket sales of so-called "kid gangs" have been financial windfalls. Fresno has reported an income of \$16,000 from this source; San Jose \$10,000, Bakersfield \$12,000, several other clubs more than \$5,000.

Sid Gillman Gets New Chargers Pack

San Diego, Calif.—(UPI)—Sid Gillman, the man who piloted two successive Western Division American Football League champions, today was given a new three-year "no raise" contract with the San Diego Chargers.

Gillman, in the final year of a three-year agreement, said the new contract as general manager-coach would extend through the 1964 season. No salary was mentioned, although Gillman said he would not get a raise.

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Mets Beat Pirates for First Win; Giants Top Reds; LA Trips Braves

Quit? Not on your life! Casey Stengel is just getting started back on the winning road again.

"It's great to be a winner," quipped Casey Monday night when his downtrodden New York Mets finally broke a nightmarish nine-game losing streak and won their first game in history by beating the first-place Pittsburgh Pirates, 9-1.

By one of those baseball coincidences, it was also the first defeat of the season for the Pirates, who had tied a modern major league record by winning their first 10 in a row.

But even before his amazing Mets, as Stengel called them, overpowered the Pirates on Jay Hook's fine five-hit pitching, Casey made it plain he will stick it out to the bitter end.

"I have no intention of quitting," the 71-year-old Casey insisted. "I'm gonna see this thing through and I'm not gonna give up."

Players Mob Hook

Hook, a 25-year-old right-hander picked up from the Cincinnati Reds in last October's expansion draft, was mobbed by the joyous Met players after his victory just as if he had won the final game of the World Series.

"He deserves all the credit," Stengel said. "He stuck right in there until the end and he looked like he could go on all night."

Had the Mets lost, they would have set a National League record for the most successive defeats at the outset of a season, but as it turned out they came up with their greatest run total of the young season and Hook became the first Met pitcher to go the route.

Hook, who walked only one batter and struck out two, aided his own cause with a bases-loaded single during a four-run second inning rally. Loser Tom Sturdivant also gave up two runs in the first frame.

Giants, Dodgers Win

In other National League games, the San Francisco Giants beat the Cincinnati Reds, 4-1, and the Los Angeles Dodgers defeated the Milwaukee Braves, 3-2. The Houston-Philadelphia game, which was the only other one scheduled, was postponed because of wet grounds.

All American league clubs were idle.

Southpaw Billy Pierce scored his second straight victory over the Reds with a seven-hit effort for the Giants. Cincinnati catcher Hank Foiles was the "goat," committing a passed ball with the bases loaded in the first inning and throwing wildly to first with the bases full again in the second while trying to pick off Willie Mays.

Burdette Loses Third

Harvey Kuenn collected three of the Giants' seven hits and teammate Ed Bailey homered. Jim O'Toole, charged with his second loss against one victory, allowed only three hits in seven innings but gave his own game by walking seven.

Young Joe Moeller scattered nine hits in winning his first major league game for the Dodgers. His mound opponent, Lew Burdette, suffered his third loss without a victory.

John Roseboro and Willie Davis hit homers for the Dodgers. Davis' wallop coming on a "second chance." The Dodgers had complained early that Burdette wasn't making proper contact with the pitching rubber. They squawked again in the fifth after Davis had flied out.

Their second complaint was heeded and Davis was recalled to bat all over again. Given another chance, he connected for a 400-foot homer.
