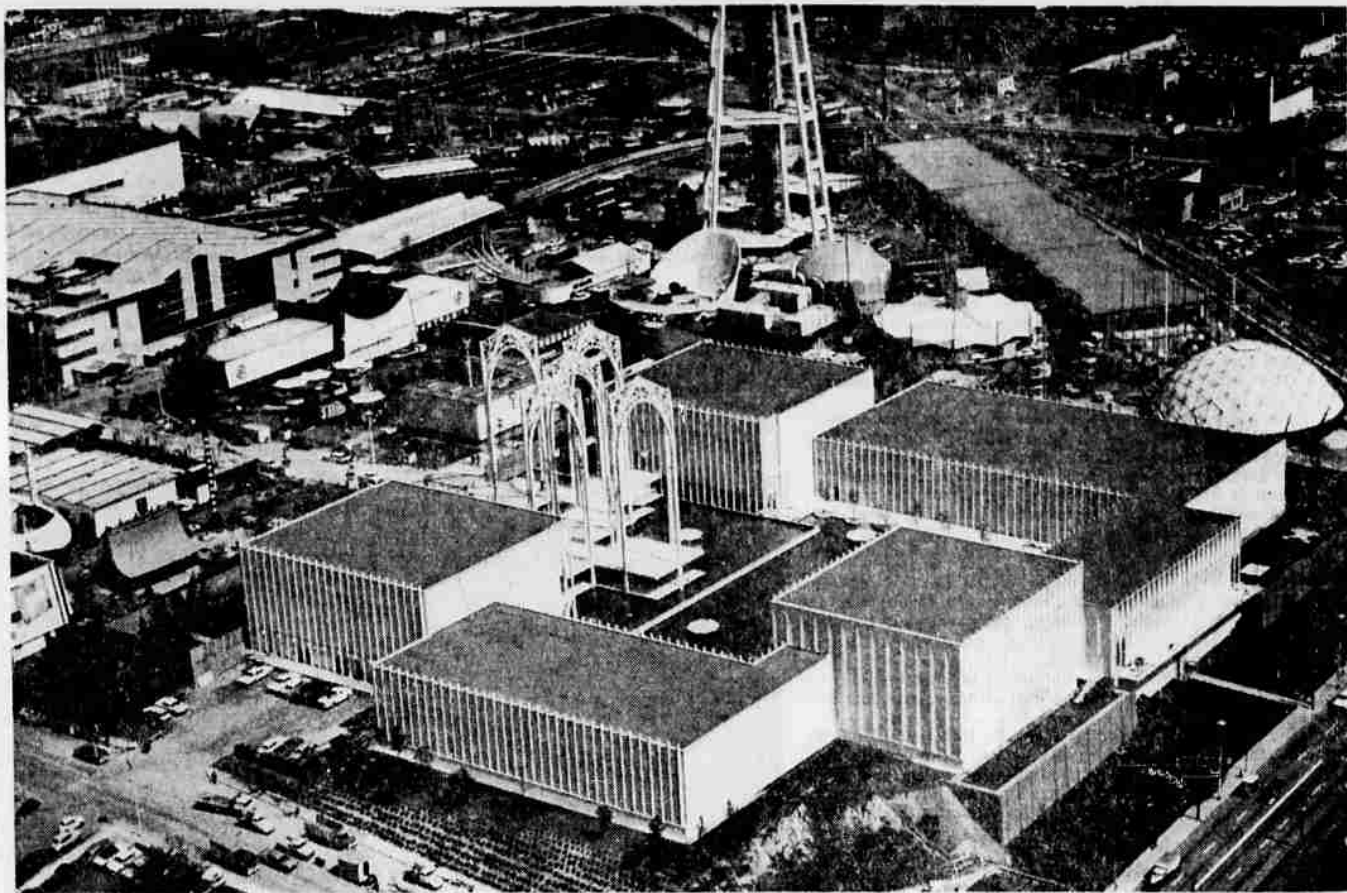




The \$10 million U.S. Science pavilion, a beautiful compound of graceful lines and refreshing pools.

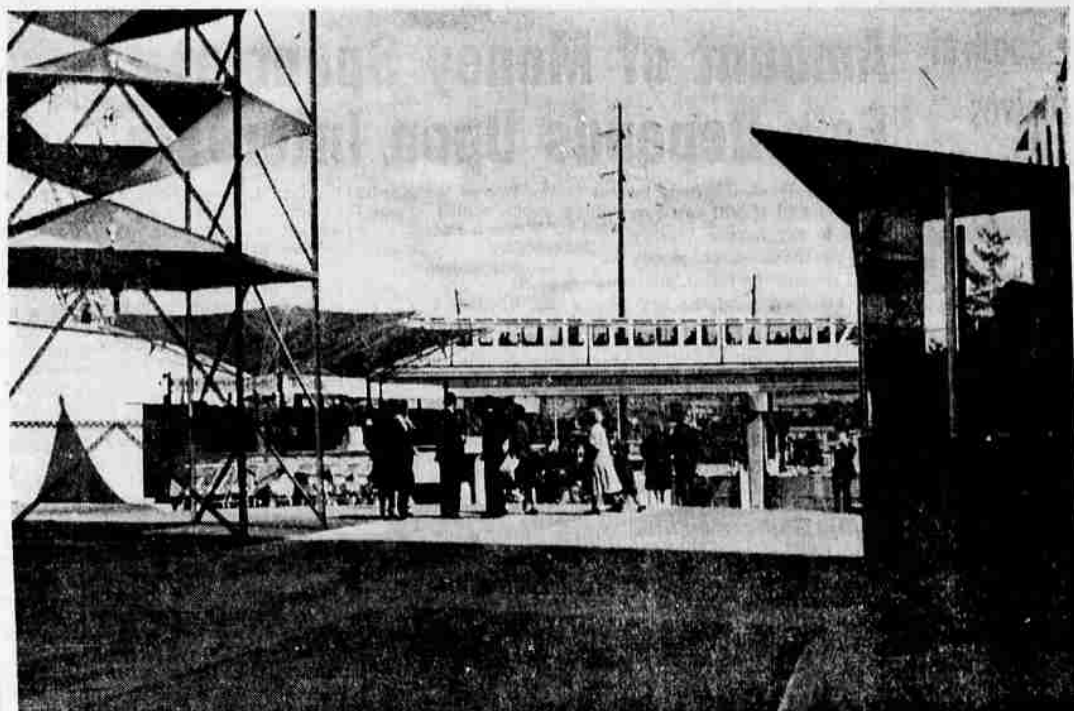

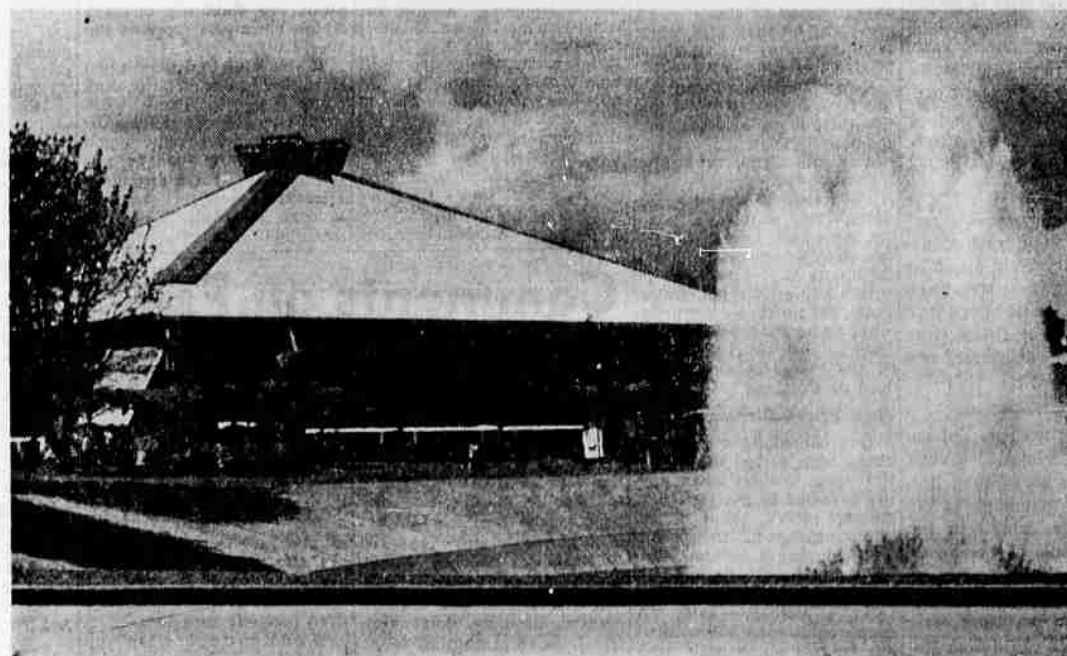
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The Gayway at the Seattle World's Fair is popular with children.
