Signal Notifies

New York-AP-Did you find it up a long day of many interruptions at the office and climb in your car tonight, thinking you were safe from messages at least for the trip home?

Live up that peaceful interlude while you can. It isn't going to last long. Science is gaining on you.

Pages Subscribers

Western Electric has announced that it has reached the point where it can make a personal signalling system—it calls it the "Bellboy"—available in 15 to 20 United States cities between now and the end of next year.

It is designed to page subscribers on the move—to signal them to get to the nearest telephone and call office, home or any other predetermined number.

The Bellboy is a small radio receiver which would fit into a topcoat or overcoat pocket. When a signal is broadcast, it emits a call tone. The person calling the customer within the service area dials a seven-digit number. The first three digits signal in the telephone central office which has Bellboy facilities, and the last four numbers signal the party carrying the Bellboy.

Callers Notified

According to the operation described in WE News Features, a company magazine, a recorded announcement notifies the caller that his call has been accepted; the central office equipment puts the call into a coded radio signal which is broadcast in the area, and activates only the receiver carried by the person who is called.

When the called person gets the signal, he presses a button to shut off the alarm, then goes to the nearest telephone and calls the number of his office or his home, wherever he knows the signal originated.
