

Burleson Runs 4:01.2 Mile as Oregon Wins

Eugene — (UPI) — Oregon's powerful track forces set seven meet records and had three more wiped out by excessive wind Saturday in demolishing Oregon State 98-45 in a dual meet.

The victory gave Oregon eight straight meet victories this year, 35 wins in a row against Northern division foes and 36 straight dual meet triumphs at home.

Collegiate high hurdles champion Jerry Tarr was clocked in 13.5 for the highs, the best in the nation this year, but a 5.5 mile-an-hour wind kept him from setting

meet and field records. The same thing happened to him in a 23.0 low hurdles effort.

Sprinter Harry Jerome came within a tenth of a second of the world's record with a 9.3 clocking in the 100 and also won the 220 in 20.7. A five mile-an-hour wind rubbed out a record in the latter event, however.

American mile record holder Eryl Burleson toured the distance in 4:01.2, the best time of the college season.

Oregon State won only two events and tied for first in another.

Crater 2nd in Bend Invitational Meet

Bend — Bend High school won its own invitational track meet here Saturday afternoon by edging Crater of Central Point by 5 1/2 points.

The Lava Bears scored 50 1/2

to 45 by the Comets. Redmond was third with 38 and Lakeview fourth with 25.

Other scores were Madras 23 1/2, The Dalles 17, Prineville 7, Burns 2 1/2 and West 1.

Running events were in metric distances.

Champ Double Winner

John Champ took first for Crater in the high and low hurdles and the Crater team of Champ, Paul Branson, Vern Swanson and Joe McCauley won the relay. Second places won by Crater were Branson in the broad jump and Dwight James in the high jump. Taking thirds were Dave Molloy in the shot put, Dave Burns in the discus, Chuck Taylor in the broad jump, Darrell Badger in the 1,500 meters and Swanson in the 400 meters.

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Decidedly Shatters Track Mark to Win Kentucky Derby

Louisville, Ky. — (UPI) — Decidedly, a big gray colt from California, shattered the 22-year-old track record at Churchill Downs Saturday with a tremendous run through the stretch to win the Kentucky Derby and erase Whirlaway's almost impregnable mark from the record books.

With jockey Bill Hartack in the saddle Decidedly came up from far back with a lightning burst of speed that carried him to a two and a quarter length victory in the sparkling time of 2:00 2/5.

The time easily beat the record established by Whirlaway in 1941 when Mr. Longtail was timed in 2:01 2/5.

Roman Line, tabbed as a speed horse who never could last for the Kentucky Derby distance of a mile and a quarter was a surprise second while favored Ridan was third in the field of 15 of the

best 3-year-olds in the country who were able to get to the post.

Never before had this son of Determine, the 1954 Kentucky Derby winner, won a

stakes race but under the careful training of Horatio Luro he was a dead hit horse for the greatest race in America and he responded with a performance such as noted cham-

pions of the past as Count Fleet, Assault, Citation, Swaps, Tim Tam and all the others never were able to match.

Decidedly, owned and bred by the El Peco Ranch of George A. Pone of San Francisco, carried Hartack to his third victory in the first of the triple crown classics. Before Hartack had won with Iron Liege in 1957 and with Venetian Way in 1960.

The California-bred colt was third choice with one of the largest of Kentucky Derby crowds and he paid \$19.40, \$8.20 and \$4.20 across the board.

Roman Line, winner of the Derby trial on Tuesday and appearing in his fourth race in two weeks, returned \$19.20 and \$7.60 while Ridan, the favorite after Sir Gaylord was withdrawn because of injury yesterday, paid \$3.00.

Medford Overruns Klamath in Track

Scott Eaton was the victor in three events and Steve Toews cracked his own school record in the half-mile here yesterday as the Medford high Black Tornado track and field team overran Klamath Falls 94 to 28.

Medford thinculds won firsts in 10 of the events and swept all points in five of them.

Toews toured the 880-yarder in 1:58.5 to shear two-tenths of a second off his previous Medford school best, Medford's Don Snodgrass was second in 1:59.4 which is his personal best.

Eaton captured the high hurdles in 15.1 and the lows in 20.7. He won the high at 6 feet 1/4 inch.

Bob Dearing gained two of Klamath Falls' four firsts. He nabbed the javelin with 182

feet and the shot put with 49-10 1/2. Other KF victors were Grover Dahn with 23.0 in the 220-yard dash and Bill Mills with 132 feet in the discus.

Falls But Wins

Jim Hill, Medford's power-running sprinter, spilled off his blocks at the start of the 100-yard dash but still won the race with 10 seconds flat.

Other victories for the Tornado were posted by Dennis Brumback with 4:32.6 in the mile, Scott Hampton with \$1.5 in the 440 run, Jim Cain with 19-11 in the broad jump, Lloyd Hammons and DeWayne Turpin with a tie at 12-1 1/2 in the pole vault and by the relay squad of Hampton, Wilt Verstrate, Eaton and Jim Henry in 1:33.

Medford sweeps were in the high hurdles, the 100, the half-mile, the pole vault and the broad jump.

Hill pulled a muscle while warming up for the broad jump and did not enter that event, the 220 yd. relay.

In a companion meet the McLoughlin Junior High school ninth downed the Klamath frosh 66 1/2 to 55 1/2.
