Plane Crash Hurts Willamette Student

Eugene—UPI—A Willamette University student was injured when his light plane crashed into a wooded area about 4 miles east of here Thursday.

The student, Ted Alexander, 21, Salem, was hospitalized at Eugene. He suffered a broken ankle and lacerations. Alexander was flying from Eugene to Redmond as part of an Air Force ROTC training program. The one-engine plane, a Cessna 107, crashed three miles southeast of Belknap Springs. The aircraft, owned by the Snyder Aviation Co. of Salem, was demolished. Alexander, who walked out to a highway and was picked up by a passing motorist, told the Lane county sheriff's office the plane lost power and nose-dived into the trees.
