## Resignations of Ashland Coach, Teacher Accepted

Ashland-The resignation of Ashland High school football coach Alfred Knutson and another teacher were accepted earlier this week.

Knutson's letter of resignation indicated he will take a position in Seattle. Also resigning was Marvin Seeman, a junior high industrial arts teacher.

In other action, the board employed eight teachers, sold three houses, decided to seek quotations on boiler insurance and swore in two newly elected board members.

Employed were Harry Wright, senior high science; Kathy Voorhies, junior high home economics; Ted Pauck, Lincoln fourth grade; Barbara Baratts, Briscoe third grade; Aubrey Casebier, girls physical education; Richard Copple, boys' physical education; Dorothy Rhymes, English and social studies; and Janice Gouley, Walker first grade.

Three houses on property near the high school were sold to the highest bidder, R. W. Voris bought two of them, Kenneth Westwood the other. Buyers must remove the houses from the property.

Administered the oath of office were Jack W. Williams, who was elected to a five-year term, and Robert W. O'Hara, elected for four years. They will take office officially July 1, although O'Hara is already on the board, having been appointed a year ago.

## Small Worlds Around Us

That mythical "yellow dog" which inspired the expression, "as full of fleas as..." doesn't have to play host to its unwelcome passengers any longer.

Science has come to the aid of the dog by making it pretty tough for the fleas. Because many dogs do have fleas, it was only natural that some interested persons would attempt to estimate how many fleas would be comfortable, or be resident in the hair of a dog.

Not entirely satisfied with an estimate, some folks devised a cleaning program on a flea-ridden dog, and carefully counted the pests removed from the animal. The procedure proved so interesting that other dogs were examined, the results tabulated, and an average established.

It was found, too, that there were varying degrees of tolerance in different dogs - that is, how many were necessary before the dog began to scratch himself. This depended on the individual dog's personality. Some dogs could entertain more fleas than other dogs. Some dogs, like some people, blow their tops sooner than others under the same stimuli.

The long-haired dogs, the shepherd and the collie, could harbor as many as 1,000 fleas while the short-haired ones usually played host to a couple of hundred. Of course, a large dog could accommodate more than could a small dog.

Early in the investigation it was discovered that the "yellow dog" didn't necessarily have more fleas than a black and white one. Science now knows this, and the dog should know it. But so far, no one has informed the fleas.

The flea is cleverly fitted to live in the hair of a dog, being narrow-bodied and equipped with long, strong legs, perfectly adapted to crawling in and between close-growing hairs.

The adult flea pierces the hide of the dog and drinks its fill of blood; it is the only food the little monsters ever eat. The female flea may lay her eggs in the dog's hair, but they fall out onto the floor, the rug or the davenport.

They hatch in a disgustingly short time. The larvae live on dust. If you can imagine such a diet, but they derive enough organic matter to subsist.

The very young fleas can coast along for weeks, without a mouthful of food, and remain dormant. A sudden vibration can wake them up, and start them on a hunt for a dog of any color.

Various methods have been tried to rid the family dog of fleas. Now it looks like a solution has been found. The veterinarian can administer a series of tablets which, working on the inside, can drive the fleas working on the outside to take off for more palatable pastures. Even the "yellow dog" can be made "flealess."
