

Condon High Nips Prospect Nine In Class B Diamond Quarterfinal

Prospect - Condon High school utilized a double steal maneuver here yesterday afternoon to tabulate the winning run in an extra-inning Oregon Class B championship quarterfinal baseball game.

The Blue Devils, clad in red and gray, nosed Prospect 4 to 3 in eight frames and will advance into next week's semifinal action.

Condon fashioned the triumph with the aid of three-hit, 15-strikeout pitching of Everett Bredimas. Hits by Dave Low and Calvin Brooks figured in the Devil scoring.

The fracas, marred by rain, went into extra session after Brooks connected for a sixth inning home run blast, tying the mix at 3-all, and neither team could score again in the regulation seven frames.

In the top of the eighth Low grounded out but Brooks lined a single into left field. Next, Mike Parish boarded first base on an error which allowed Brooks to reach third sack. Bill Johnson replaced Wally Nye on the hill for the home team Cougars.

As Johnson faced pinch batter Bud Logan, Parish dashed for second. Johnson turned and threw to shortstop Terry Gardner and Brooks broke for home. Parish was tagged out but Brooks scored on the play.

Lead Switches
In the bottom of the eighth Johnson popped out. Cougar hopes stayed alive when Dick Bean was hit by a pitch and swiped second. But pinch hitter Jerry Wilson and Bill Hunt whiffed to end the game.

Condon nabbed a first inning 1 to 0 lead. Prospect pushed on top 2 to 1 in the third canto. The Blue Devils of Coach Harvey Neffendorf knotted action in the top of the fourth and Prospect hopped in front again 3 to 2 in the bottom of the panel.

Both of the early Devil markers were tallied on wild pitches. In the first inning Steve Carrine walked and swiped second. He advanced to third when Pat Tierney was thrown out at first base after a dropped third strike. The wild pitch followed. For the fourth inning counter Low singled and moved to second when Brooks was hit by a pitch. A balk advanced both runners, setting the stage before the bum toss.

For the Cougars of Coach Duane Payne in the third inning Gardner walked and stole second base. Johnson plastered the ball into right field for a three base blast, scoring Terry. Johnson crossed the platter when Dick Bean singled.

Walks to Larry Bean and Bob Scott set up the third

score for the Prospect gang. They advanced when left-fielder Dennis Ashenfetter bunted and dropped a fly by Gardner. Centerfielder Brooks retrieved the ball and threw wild past third base, allowing Bean to tally.

Nye knocked the ball into left field in the first inning for Prospect's first hit. Jim O'Meara smacked one of the safe blows for Condon. Brooks belted his homer into right center field.

While chalking up his many strikeouts and limiting the Cougar hits, Bredimas gave Prospect scoring chances by issuing eight free passes. He walked six batters and hit two. The Cougars left eight runners stranded, including three in the first inning.

Nye, pitching 7½ innings for the Cougars, chucked a four-hitter, striking out eight, walking three and hitting one batter. Johnson, finishing, registered one strikeout and gave two bases on balls.

Rain came down hard at times. It fell during the first three innings of the game, let up, then resumed in the seventh.

Prospect, in state baseball playoffs for the first time, was District 5B titlist. Condon won in District 6.

The Cougars' Arthur Andersen played most of the game at first base hobbling on an injured leg. He was hurt in

a collision in the second inning. Ashenfetter bunted and brushed into Andersen as he made the tag. Andersen continued in the game until lifted in the bottom of the eighth frame for pinch hitter Wilson. He covered first sack for eight putouts after the injury.

Phil Moyer Substitute For Denny

New York (UPI)—Phil Moyer of Portland was named to substitute for his brother Denny in next Saturday's nationally televised 10-round bout against Teddy Wright at Madison Square Garden.

Denny withdrew from the bout because of an infection in his left ear. Brother Phil has scored 25 victories, including nine knockouts, in his career with five losses and one draw. He has won his only two fights this year, knocking out Herb Le Seur and outpointing George Wright.

Davises Spark Dodgers To Victory Over Giants

Los Angeles (UPI)—What a difference a Davis makes—and for the Los Angeles Dodgers who have two Davises it means a difference of two games.

The unrelated Davis boys, Tommy and Willie, again teamed up Tuesday night—Tommy powering his second two-run homer in as many games and Willie singling twice and driving in two runs—to give the Dodgers a 5-1 victory over San Francisco.

The Dodgers swept the two-game series from the Giants, limiting San Francisco to a run in each game, and cutting the Giants' National League lead to 2½ games. They came into town Monday with a 4½ game margin over second-place Los Angeles and St. Louis.

Big Stan Williams provided the Dodgers with their second straight line pitching job—a performance that would have enabled the talents of either Davis to gain the victory.

Williams gave up a single to leadoff batter Harvey Kuenn to open the game. The next Giant hit was Willie Mays' leadoff double in the

sixth. When Chuck Hiller singled to right the Giants had their only run.

Sherry Takes Over
However, the opening two San Francisco batters in the ninth lined singles and Dodger manager Walt Alton changed pitchers. Reliever Larry Sherry ended the affair quickly as Jose Pagan hit into a double play and Willie McCovey grounded out.

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
