Medical Care for Fishermen Voted

Washington—UPI—The Senate Commerce Committee has approved a medical care proposal for fishermen.

The measure would allow some 11,000 self-employed fishermen or owner-operators of fishing vessels to obtain medical care under the public health service act.

Sen. Warren Magnuson (D-Wash.), chairman of the committee, said that thousands of fishermen shared medical services provided by the government until 1954.

However, in 1954, an administrative ruling excluded working owners or part-owners of fishing boats from medical care benefits, limiting them only to crew members.

Magnuson and Sen. E. L. Bartlett (D-Alaska), introduced the legislation.

SEES BILL'S DEFEAT

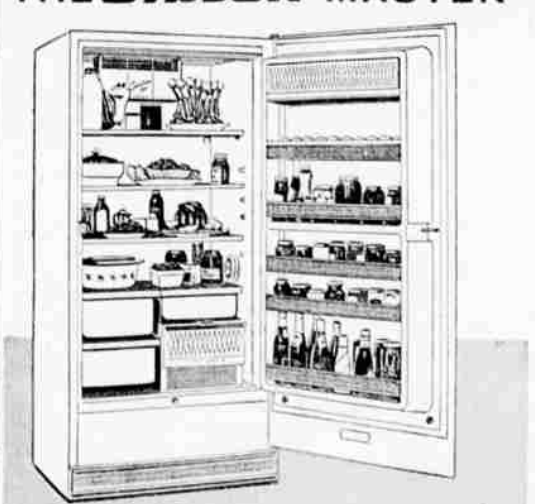
