

# Jackson Project Biggest of Bids On Highway Jobs

Salem — A paving and signing job covering 9.45 miles on the 12th st.-North Ashland interchange on the Pacific Highway was the biggest of the bids on 42 projects which the Oregon Highway Department opened here Wednesday.

The combined bids totaled \$4.8 million and ran only 2.1 per cent under department estimates.

The Jackson county bid, submitted jointly by Fred H. Slater and E. C. Hall, both of Portland, was for \$2,123,110.

Two projects were withdrawn from bidding and will come up later. They include traffic signals on the Pacific Highway East and River rd. in Milwaukie, and the painting of the Union ave. and Grand ave. bridges over railroad tracks and the Banfield Expressway in Portland.

The highway commission will meet here Friday to award contracts. Other apparent low bidders include:

Baker: Pleasant Valley section, Old Oregon Trail Highway, .81 of a mile of slide fixing; Hamer Corp., Portland \$158,860.

Benton, Linn and Lincoln: Point Alsea river bridge and Willamette river bridge in Corvallis, C. H. Savage, Portland, \$22,897.

Clackamas: Mt. Scott Creek and Rock Creek sections, route 134, .87 of a mile grading, paving; Steelman Duff, Portland \$144,844.

Clatsop: Astoria Ferry channel dredging; Port of Astoria, \$31,996.

Clatsop and Washington: Elsie-Strassel undercrossing section, Sunset highway, 1.37 miles grading and 9.4 miles paving; Acme Construction, Redmond, Wash., \$274,430.

Coos: Davis Slough bridge section, Coos-Bay-Roseburg Highway, grading, paving, a structure; North Bend dredging; North Bend \$93,602.

Deschutes: Deschutes county roads on routes 691 and 691; Babler Bros., Portland, \$14,930.

Jackson: Crater Lake Interchange lighting on Seven Oaks-Jackson st. section of Pacific Highway in Medford area; Steeck Electric, Medford \$11,890.

Jackson: Rock Point-Seven Oaks section, Pacific Highway, a railroad overcrossing and widen a frontage road overcrossing near Gold Hill; Peter Kiewit Sons, Medford, \$148,345.

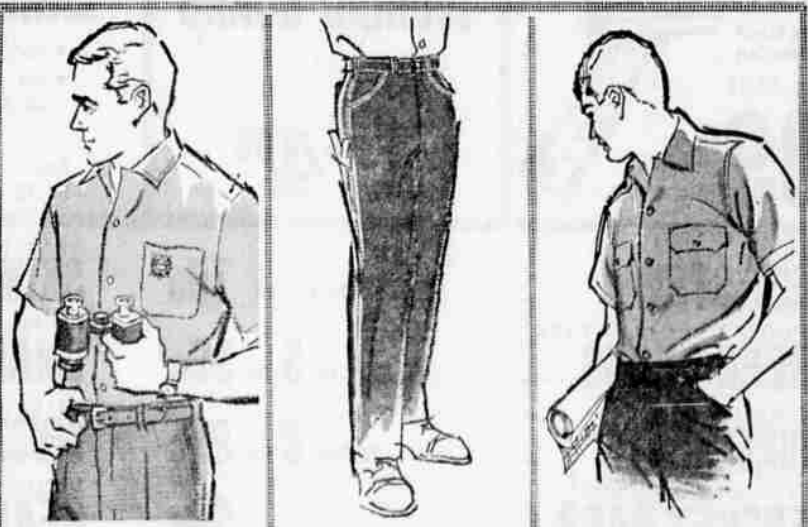
