

Railroad Parley Set for Monday

Chicago —(UPI)— The nation's railroads and five operating unions, at a seeming impasse over proposed work rules changes, today agreed to postpone until next week their scheduled meeting to renew negotiations under the guidance of federal mediators.

Spokesmen for the unions said the postponement until next Monday was agreed upon so each side could marshal new approaches to the start of negotiations.

The agreement to talk again came after Labor Secretary Arthur J. Goldberg reminded

both parties that the national interest was involved in their deliberation.

At issue are demands from both sides to revise work rules applying to 210,000 rail employees and a presidential commission report recommending, among other things, elimination of 40,000 firemen's jobs.

Both sides have criticized the voluminous report. Under the Railway Labor Act, it is not binding and the unions have said they refuse to recognize it as a basis for negotiations.

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Military School Founder Dies

Portland —(UPI)— Col. Burton B. Millard, founder of two military prep schools, died in a hospital here Wednesday night.

The 60-year-old Millard had been admitted for a heart condition following an attack of pneumonia.

Col. Millard, a 1924 graduate of West Point, first established a school to prepare boys

for the Academy in Washington, D. C., the following year. The school functioned until 1918, and in 1933 he opened another to train boys for all the service academies at Langlois, Ore.

At the time of his death, construction had started on a new boys' school which he was building at Bandon, Ore. More than 90 graduates of

his Washington school have become generals.

During World War II he served in the United States and in North Africa. He later was executive officer to the secretary general of the Nuremberg Trials.

He is survived by his widow, the former Esther Lound of Washington, D. C. Mrs. Millard said construction of the new school at Bandon will continue.

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Union To Appeal Monitor Decision

Portland —(UPI)— The attorney of local 701 of the Holston and Portable Engineers said today the union will appeal a Circuit court decision to monitor the local's next election.

Clifford D. O'Brien said the appeal is planned to the Oregon Supreme court.

Circuit Judge James W. Crawford handed down the decision last month following an eight-day trial on charges by six union members against local officers.

City Police Install Board for Bulletins

A 4 by 8-foot bulletin board has been installed just inside the entrance of the Medford city police station in city hall.

The board will be used to display FBI posters of the 10 most wanted criminals in the United States, according to Chief of Police Charles P. Champlin.

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
