### Jackson Project Listed in Request For Highway Bids

Salem—(UPI)—The Oregon Highway commission has asked contractors to bid on about \$16.2 million worth of projects throughout the state. The bids will be opened here June 27 and contracts will be awarded June 29.

Projects include:

**Baker county:** Pine creek rd.-Pocahontas section, county road 506, 1.5 miles leveling, oiling.

**Clackamas:** Milwaukie traffic signals at River rd. and the Pacific highway.

**Clackamas:** Morris bridge over Butte creek southeast of Woodburn.

**Clackamas and Marion:** Monitor bridge over Butte creek northeast of Mt. Angel.

**Clackamas and Marion:** Ross bridge over Butte creek east of Mt. Angel.

**Clatsop and Pacific County, Wash.:** Substructure for steel spans, Columbia river bridge at Astoria and Megler, Wash.

**Coos:** Salmon creek section, Rock creek county road, 41 of a mile grading.

**Coos:** 10th at 7th st. section, Empire-Coos Bay Highway, traffic signals on Central ave.

**Coos:** Install latrine at Cape Arago State park.

**Curry:** Grade, pave 11 of a mile on Center st. in Brookings.

**Deschutes:** Install latrine in Tumalo State park.

**Douglas:** Yoncalla interchange-Rice Hill section, Pacific Highway, 3.20 miles

### Airline Reports Passenger Increase

West Coast Airlines has announced that it flew 10.3 per cent more passengers in May, 1962, than in May, 1961, for a total of 33,863 passengers.

Revenue passenger miles increased 10.9 per cent with 8,251,765 this year, compared to 7,404,604 last year, airline officials said.

Cities boarding more passengers than any other May in the company's history were Boise, Ephrata, Lewiston, Pasco, Salt Lake City, San Francisco, Seattle, Spokane and Walla Walla.

The West Coast Airlines Tri-Cities stop as Pasco not only boarded more passengers than any other May of the company's operation there, but boarded more passengers than in any previous month in its entire history.

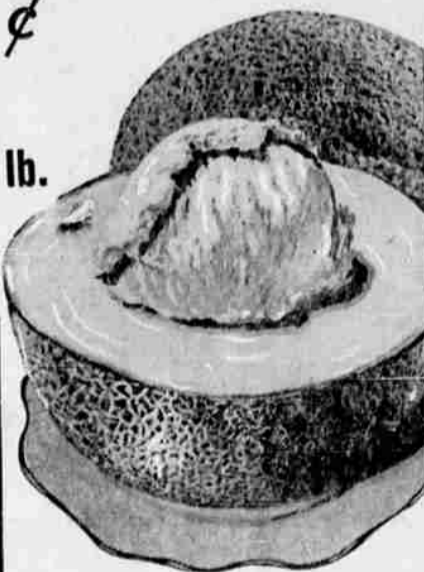
**Washington:** Grade, pave 18 of a mile on Sunset ave. in Banks.
