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Rehearsals Start for 1962 Oregon Shakespearean Plays

Ashland — Cast lists were posted Sunday for the 1962 season of the Oregon Shakespearean Festival in Ashland. Assignment of the season's 97 name roles came Saturday evening, when directors gathered to cast the four Shakespearean productions.

Casting of the Festival's special dance-music production of "A Thieve's Ballad" will bring the total name roles to 102, distributed among a 33-member acting company.

Rehearsals began immediately Sunday afternoon in preparation for the July 21 launching of the six week run.

Popular Performers

Popular performers from previous seasons gained key assignments this year. Charles Taylor, in Ashland for his third summer, will be seen as Cominius in "Coriolanus," Northumberland in "Henry IV, Part II," Corin in "As You Like It," and the Merchant in "Comedy of Errors." In his third Ashland season, Les Carlson returns as Orlando in "As You Like It" and as Shadow in "Henry IV, Part II."

Producing Director Angus L. Bowmer will repeat his successful role as Silence in "Henry." In her fifth performance season, Shirley Patton will appear as Doll Tear-sheet in "Henry." Michael Fuchs, in his third Ashland

season, will play Duke Senior in "As You Like It," Angelo in "Comedy," and the Archbishop in "Henry."

Three-season veteran Michael Addison, 1962's Festival stage manager, portrays Fang in "Henry." Hugh Evans, Druggist in the 1961 "Alchemists," will mark his fifth Ashland summer playing Shallow in "Henry." Directing 1962's "Comedy of Errors" and appearing as Warwick in "Henry" will be veteran actor-director Jerry Turner.

Performers from 1961 have again drawn important roles for their second round in Ashland. Peter MacLean (Claudius in "Hamlet") gained the title roles in "Coriolanus" and "Henry IV, Part II," along with Antipholus of Ephesus in "Comedy of Errors." Rod Alexander (1961's King Henry IV) will perform Menenius in "Coriolanus."

Elizabeth Huddle (Dol Common in "Alchemist") returns as Rosalind in "As You Like It," Mistress Quickly in "Henry," and Luce in "Comedy of Errors." The Player Queen in "Hamlet" in 1961, Susan Brewer, will be seen as Volumentia in "Coriolanus" and as Adriana in "As You Like It." Ric Murphy (Blument in "Henry IV") is set for Dromio of Ephesus in "Comedy" and as Mouldy in "Henry."

Charles Miller (Flute in "Midsummer Night's Dream") will perform La Beau in "As You Like It," Dr. Pinch in "Comedy," and Hastings in "Henry."

Again in 1962, many new faces will debut in Ashland with top roles. Eugene Dynarski of Long Beach City college has drawn Falstaff in "Henry IV," Duke Frederick in "As You Like It," Brutus in "Coriolanus," and Aegon in "Comedy of Errors."

William Royston, Bristol, England, portrays Aufidius in "Coriolanus," Oliver in "As You Like It," Pistol in "Henry," and Solinus in "Comedy." Stacy Keach (University of California) will be Antipholus of Syracuse in "Comedy" and Westmoreland in "Henry."

Adolph Caesar, New York university, will appear in Ashland as Gower in "Henry," and Adam in "As You Like It." Kirk Mee of the Stephens college acting company will be seen as Dromio of Syracuse in "Comedy," William in "As You Like It," and as the Porter in "Henry." Michael Percival, Stanford, will do Prince Hal in "Henry" and Amiens in "As You Like It."

Other New Actors

Other actors appearing in Ashland for their first Festival season are Daniel Hoppe (University of Illinois) as Jacques in "As You Like It," Scinius in "Coriolanus," and Surry in "Henry"; James Tripp (University of California) as Touchstone in "As You Like It" and Snare in "Henry"; Richard Ramos (Loyola) as Balthazar in "Comedy," Charles in "As You Like It," and as the Lord Chief Justice in "Henry"; Robert Cohen (Yale) as Titus Lartius in "Coriolanus" and Morton in "Henry"; Christopher Cabot (Santa Monica City college) as Mowbray in "Henry"; Jerry Rodgers, Stockton, Calif., as Bardolph in "Henry" and Dennis in "As You Like It"; Robert Bridges (Sacramento State) as Poin in "Henry" and Jacques de Bois in "As You Like It"; George Sanchez (Louisiana State university) as Silvius in "As You Like It"; and Lancaster in "Henry"; Jon Cranney (Utah State university) as the Merchant and Headman in "Comedy"; Terry Campbell (Sacramento City college) as Feeble in "Henry."

Actresses new to Ashland will also hold top roles for 1962. Donna Setrakian (San Francisco State college) will be seen this year as Aemilia in "Comedy" and as Lady Northumberland in "Henry"; Julie Townley, also of San Francisco State, appears as Virgilia in "Coriolanus," and Audrey in "As You Like It"; Sally Pagliuca from Catholic university is to be Luciana in "Comedy," Lady Percy in "Henry," and Celia in "As You Like It"; Marion Halley, of the University of Washington, will be Valeria in "Coriolanus."

Directors for 1962 and their assignments are: Rod Alexander, "Comedy of Errors"; Edward Brubaker, "Henry IV, Part II"; Jerry Turner, "As You Like It," and J. H. Crouch, "Coriolanus."

Massive Solid-Fuel Rocket Fails Test

Sacramento, Calif. —UPI— A giant solid-fuel rocket, billed as the most powerful in the free world, fizzled and blew out its tail section Saturday during a test-firing. The 80-foot rocket, built by the Aerojet-General corporation under an Air Force contract, burned successfully for 71 seconds of its scheduled two-minute duration.

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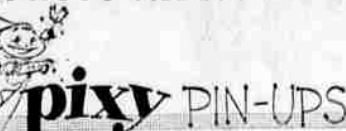
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
