

State Board Gives Approval to New Education Center

Salem - (UPI) - After considerable discussion, the State Board of Education has approved establishment of an education center composed of school district No. 62, Oregon City. This means state aid will continue for three vocational courses now being taught in Oregon City High School.

Several board members expressed reservations about the action, since it might leave the impression with Clackamas County voters that creation of the center was against the voters' wishes.
