

Eugene Emeralds Entertain Salem Dodgers at White City on Monday

Professional baseball-Class B style - returns to southern Oregon on Monday evening. And, backers are hoping it proves just as popular as it did on two occasions in 1961.

Eugene's Emeralds and Salem's Dodgers collide in a regular Northwest league skirmish at Memorial field, White City. The umpire's play ball signal is scheduled for 8 p.m.

This will be a home game for the Emeralds. It could be hot against bottom. Neither team headed the circuit after Friday's contests. In fact, Eugene was on the neither rung of the ladder. But, Salem, in third place, had the opportunity of being

leader by the time today's loop frays are over. The Dodgers were only 10 percentage points back of the loop-pacing Yakima Bears and just two points back of second spot Wenatchee.

Major Loop Frays

The game is one of four Eugene will have at White City this summer and one of two that the Dodgers will play at the Veterans Administration domiciliary. Other games are in August. Purpose of bringing the games here is to give Rogue valley people another opportunity to see pro ball and to stimulate interest here in the Northwest league. The circuit has looked to Med-

ford as a possible franchise site.

Fans will see major league farm clubs in action. Salem is tied to the Los Angeles Dodgers and Eugene to the San Francisco Giants. Virtually all the players on each aggregation are young men aiming for major league careers. The major loop clubs are keeping close tabs on them.

Mid-week statistics showed Billy Ray Jones the batting leader of Salem with .324. Wade Arnold was hitting .319 and Bill Kelsa .315. Ken Page was hitting .412 with few times at bat. For Eugene the leader was Wally Cockrell with .311. Pitcher Frank Linzy was next with .304. Carlos Dore had a .292 mark and Richard Dietz .291.

Last available dope had Darrell Peters leading Salem pitchers with 8.2 while Larry Staab was 7.2. Matt Gayeski was 6.3 for Eugene and Edgar Feldman 7.5. Linzy had 4.2. Possible Lineups

Who'll do the pitching for either team at the White City site depends on week end assignments. Possible starters other than pitchers for Eugene are Dietz, catcher; Jose Calero, 1st base; Roger Tomlinson, second base; Stan Patykula, third base; Donald Pope, shortstop; Joseph McLaughlin, left field; Dore, centerfield, and Cockrell, right field.

For Salem the lineup may be Kelsa, catcher; Dick McLaughlin, first base; Lou Er-

tie or Bob Cox, second base; Cox or Jim Shinn, third base; Ralph Plumlee, shortstop; Dick Bogard or Jones, left field; Vic Pagel, centerfield, and Tom Richards or Jones, right field.

Central Point Junior Chamber of Commerce is sponsor of the game. Jaycees have tickets at Barker's Men's store and the Bohemian club here, at the Central Point pharmacy, at Foster's pharmacy in Jacksonville, at Olsen's confectionery in Eagle Point, and at the Shady Cove tavern and cafe. They will be available at the gate on Monday.
